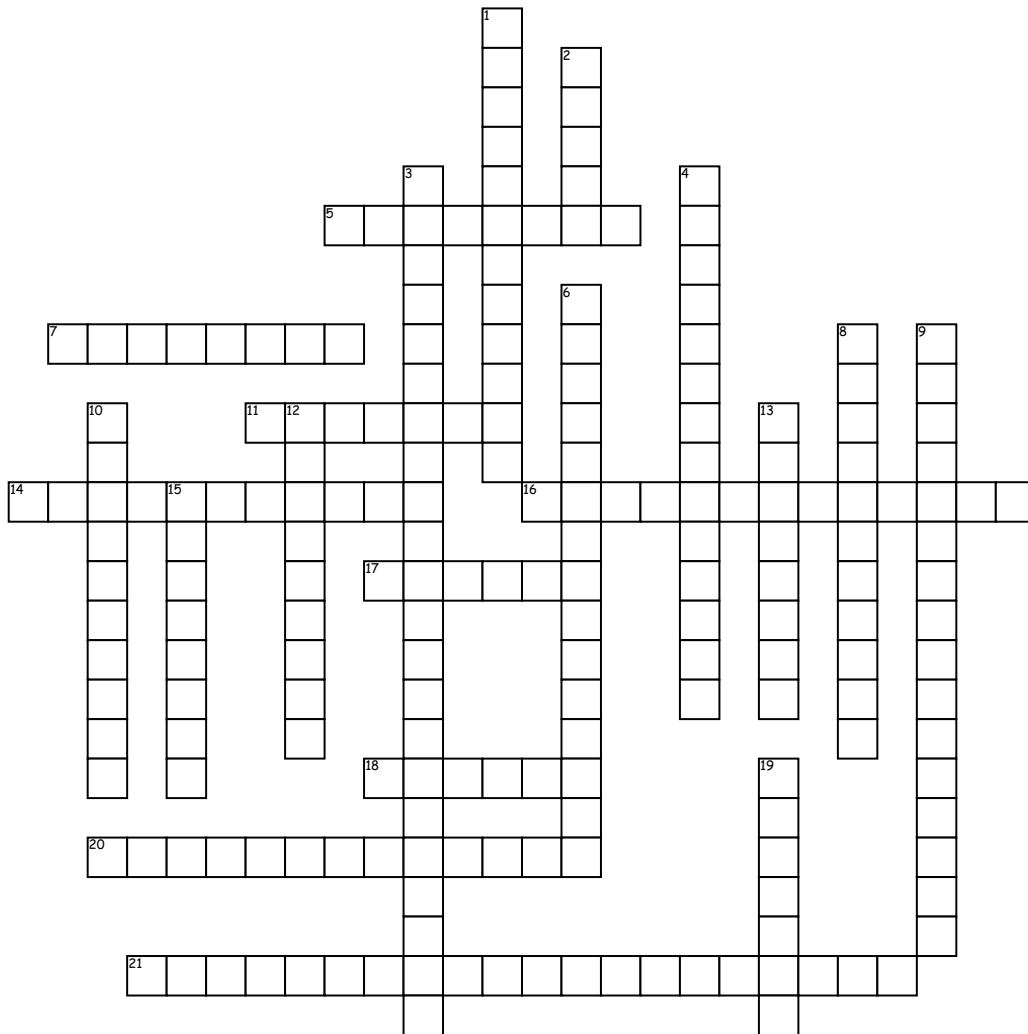

14. a birth defect in which a developing baby's spinal cord fails to develop properly
16. a congenital disorder of movement, muscle tone, or posture
17. a respiratory condition marked by spasms in the bronchi of the lungs, causing difficulty in breathing
18. a disease caused by an uncontrolled division of abnormal cells in a part of the body

1. an infectious bacterial disease causing fever and a scarlet rash. It is caused by streptococci.
2. a contagious and infectious viral disease causing swelling of the parotid salivary glands in the face, and risk of sterility in adult males
3. infectious disease caused or transmitted by a parasite that can cause itching, vomiting, fever, weight loss, and dehydration
4. an inherited life-threatening disorder that damages the lungs and digestive system
6. a common virus that can infect almost anyone and once infected your body retains the virus for life causing a weakened immune system, body aches, fever, fatigue, and sore throat

8. a sore throat with fever caused by a streptococcal infection

9. a group of disorders that cause red blood cells to become misshapen and break down
10. an infectious disease causing a mild fever and a rash of itchy inflamed blisters. It is caused by the herpes zoster virus.
12. a highly contagious viral infection of the respiratory passages causing fever, chills, sore throat, and severe aching
13. a disease in which the body's ability to produce or respond to the hormone insulin is impaired
15. a chronic, potentially life-threatening condition caused by the human immunodeficiency virus
19. an infectious viral disease causing fever and a red rash on the skin
