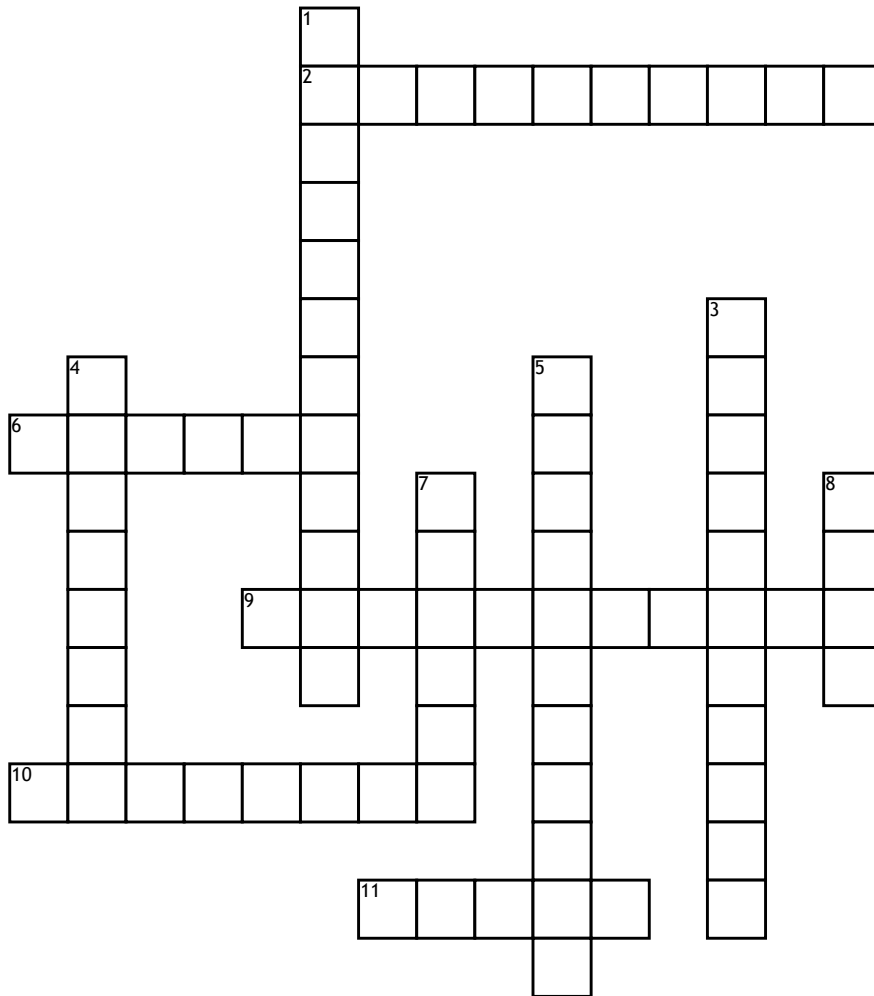

## Across

- 2. Voluntary transfer of land ownership.
- 6. A contract in which the seller agrees to sell and the buyer agrees to buy all or a specified amount of what the seller produces.
- 9. When a party is restored to the position they were in before they made a contract.
- 10. Using the predominant factor test to determine whether a sale involves primarily goods or primarily services.
- 11. Evidence between parties that is not contained in a contract they made.

## Down

- 1. A manufactured good that falls under Article 2 of the UCC.

- 3. Third party who is not part of a contract, but will benefit from the performance stated in the contract.
- 4. When a party breaches a contract and has to pay a small amount of compensation.
- 5. When supervening circumstances make it impossible for either party of a contract to perform.
- 7. transferring contractual obligations to a third party.
- 8. Excluded from Article 2 of the UCC because it cannot be moved from place to place even though it is tangible.
