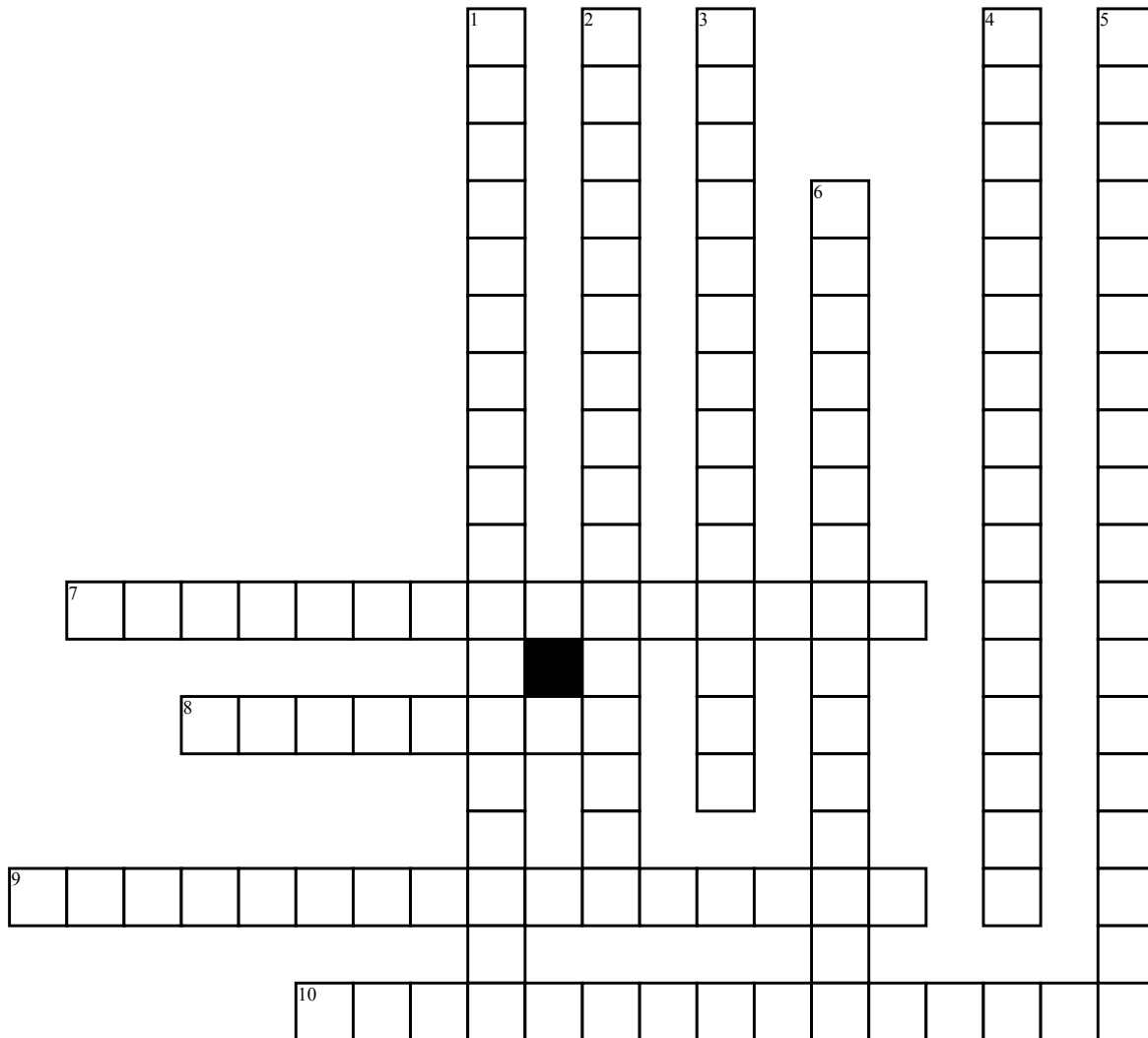

- 9. a stain that occurs while the teeth are still forming and can include stains caused by medications fluoride, drinking water, and inherited conditions
- 10. A stain that is caused by external factor's such as food, drink, and tobacco

Down

- 1. an approach to coronal polishing wherein only stained teeth are polished

- 2. angled instrument that holds the rubber cup and brush bristles used in coronal polishing; also called Prophyl angle
- 3. adherence of bacteria or discoloring agents to dental enamel that causes discoloration
- 4. Removal of stains and plaque from the clinical crown
- 5. a stain that occurs after the tooth erupts and can include stains caused by amalgam and root canal therapy
- 6. Discoloration of internal tooth structure due to external agents that have been absorbed in the tooth's structure
