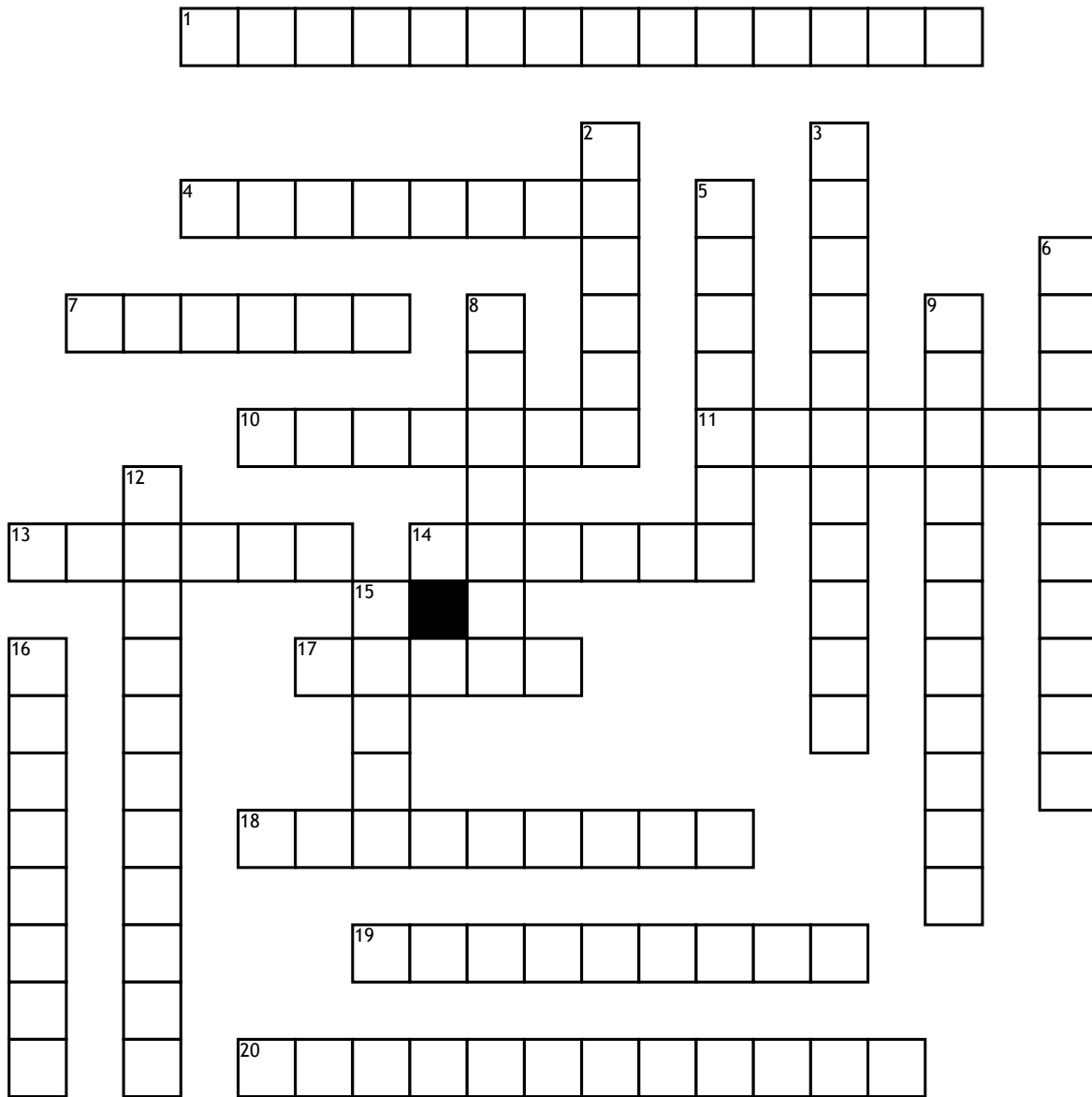


Count of Monte Cristo Vocab Crossword
