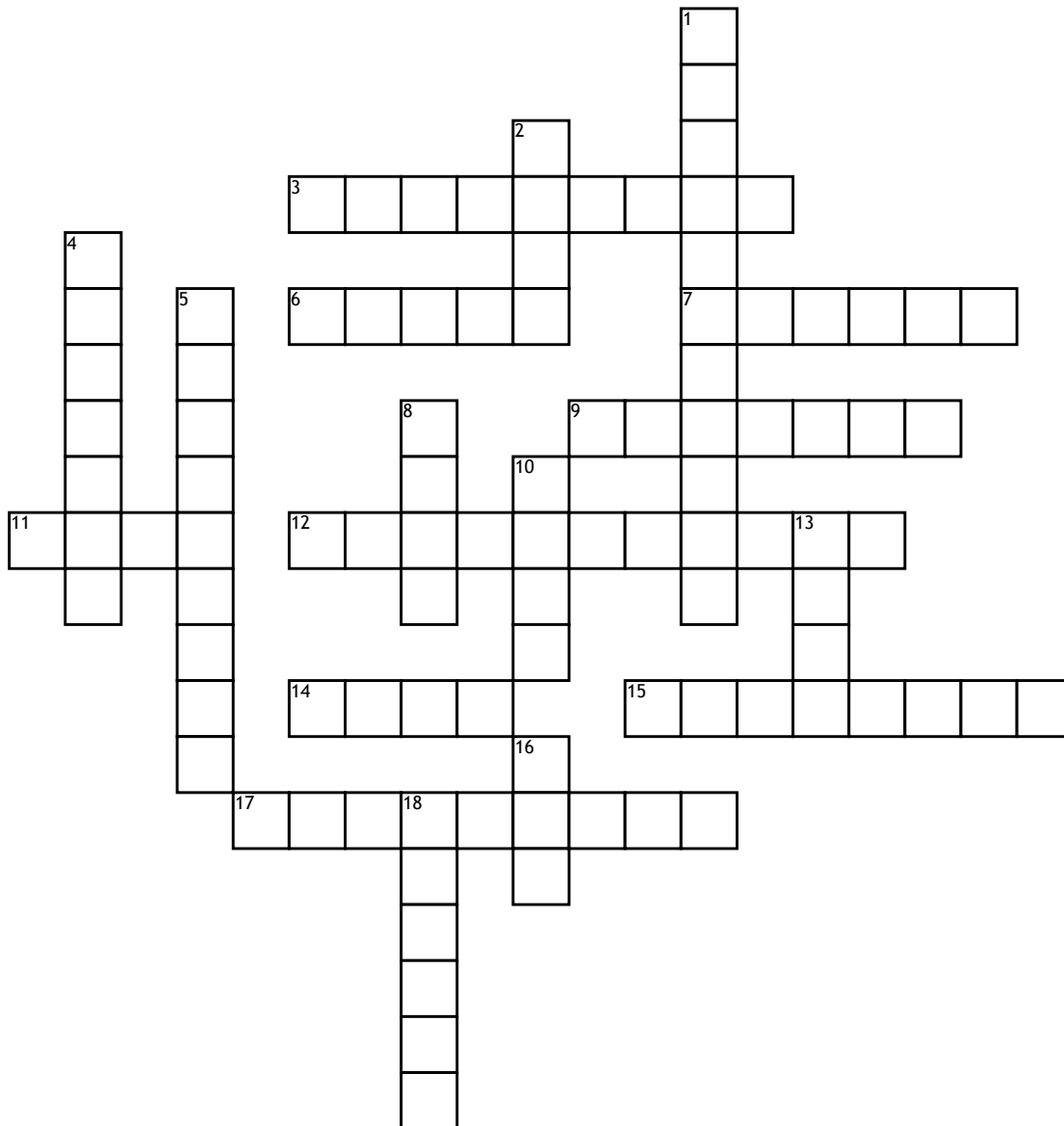


# Crashes in history crosswords
