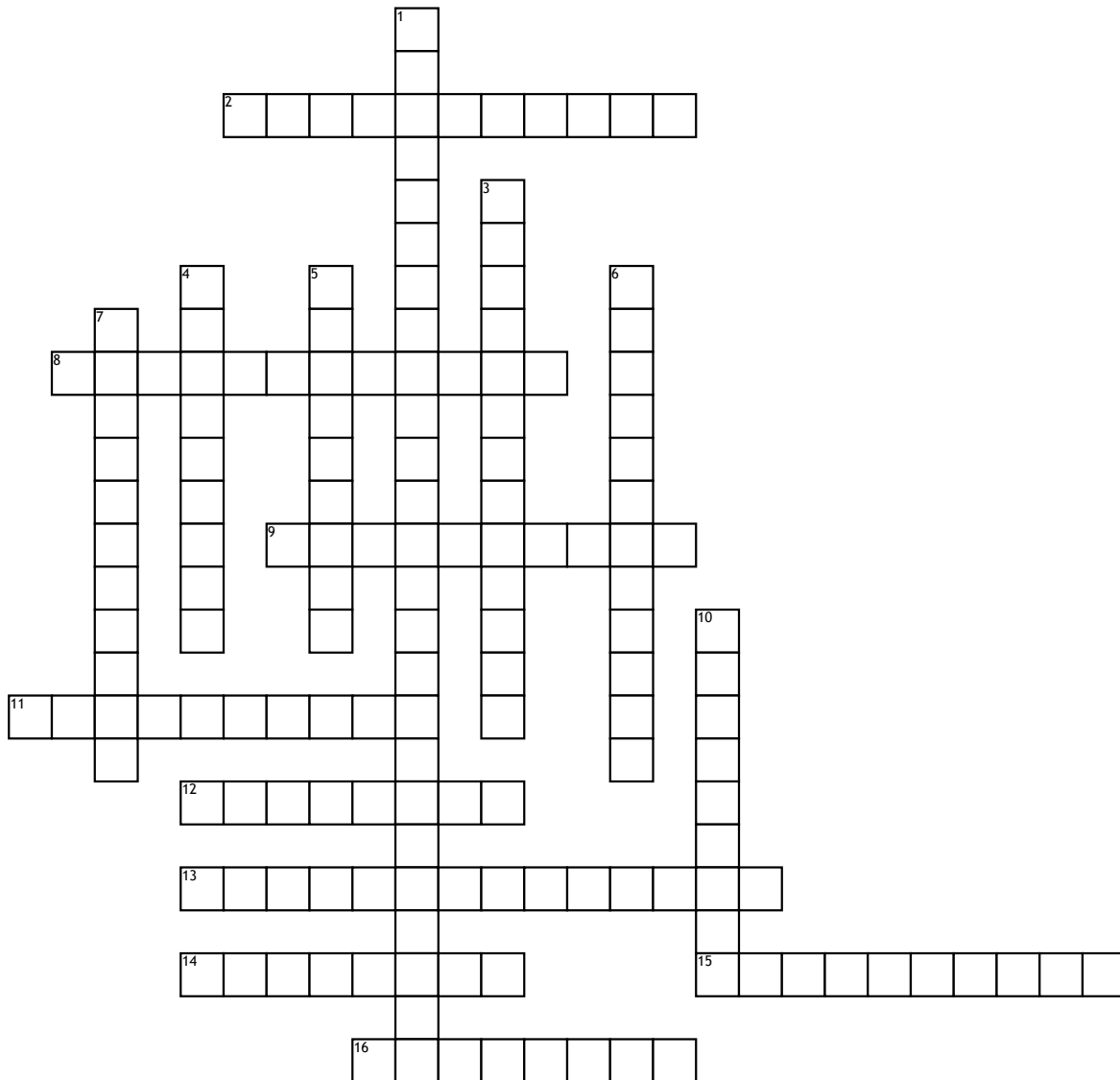


Creative Puzzle

- 2. a mucous membrane disorder characterized by white patches, especially on the cheek, tongue, vulva, or penis.
- 8. a drug that causes hallucinations, such as LSD.
- 9. a substance capable of causing cancer in living tissue.
- 11. illegal or illicit drug taking or alcohol consumption which leads a person to experience social, psychological, physical or legal problems related to intoxication or regular excessive consumption and/or dependence.
- 12. a drug or other substance affecting mood or behavior and sold for nonmedical purposes, especially an illegal one.

13. An overindulgence in or dependence on an addictive substance, especially alcohol or drugs.

- 14. promoting calm or inducing sleep.
- 15. a secondary, typically undesirable effect of a drug or medical treatment.

- 1. Blood alcohol concentration (BAC) refers to the amount of alcohol present in the bloodstream. A BAC of 0.05% (point 0 five) means that there is 0.05 grams of alcohol in every 100 millilitres of blood.
- 3. the consumption of an excessive amount of alcohol in a short period of time.

4. the ability or willingness to tolerate something, in particular the existence of opinions or behavior that one does not necessarily agree with.

- 5. a substance that raises levels of physiological or nervous activity in the body.
- 6. influence from members of one's peer group.
- 7. a habit-forming drug that, while not itself addictive, may lead to the use of other addictive drugs.
- 10. a chronic disease of the liver marked by degeneration of cells, inflammation, and fibrous thickening of tissue. It is typically a result of alcoholism or hepatitis.
