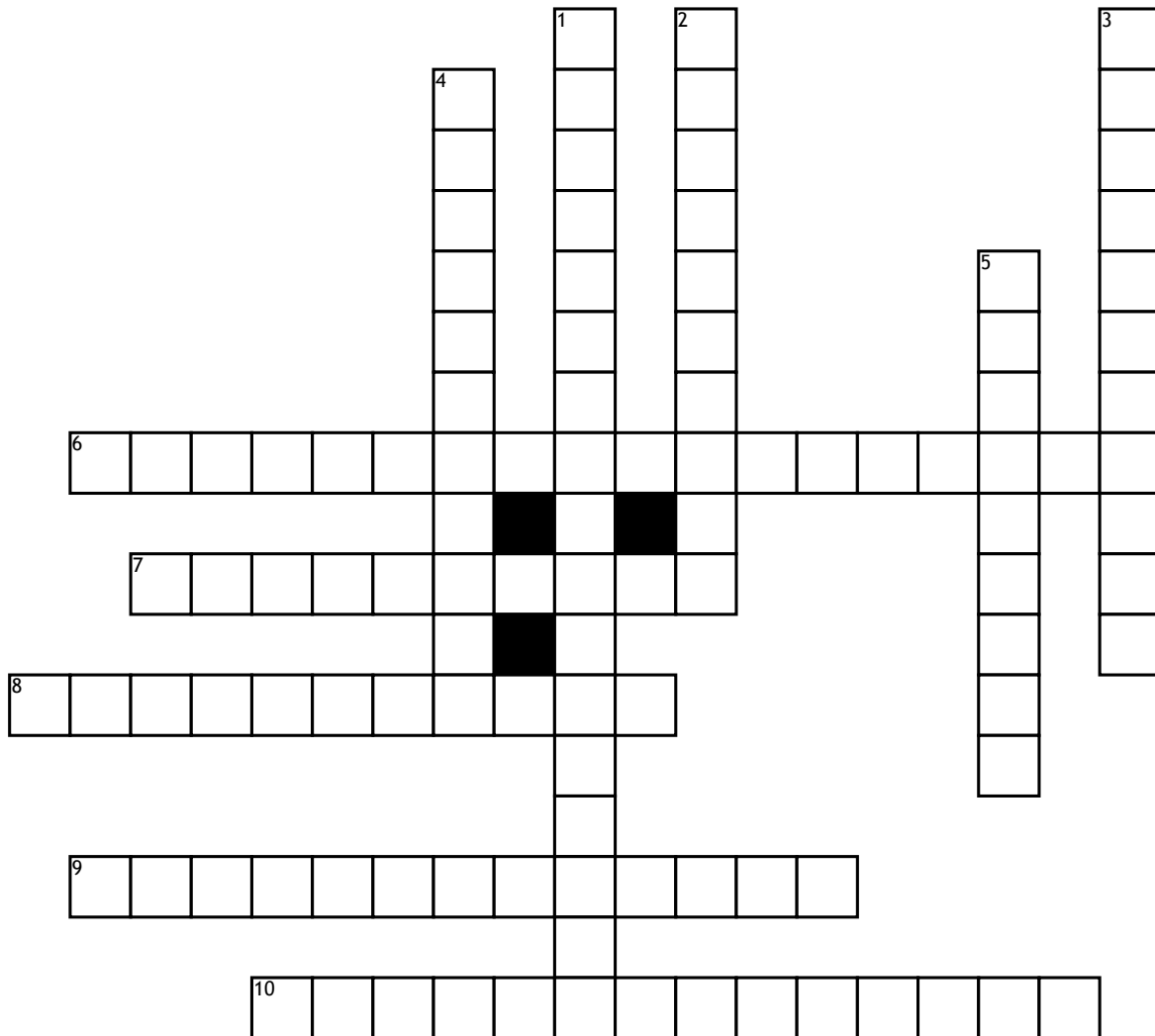


Crime and Punishment

- 1. State sanctioned execution for committing a capital offence; not legal in the UK
- 2. Aim of punishment to scare the offender into not reoffending, and scare other people into not committing that crime
- 3. Aim of punishment to give payback to the criminal who committed a crime.
- 4. Aim of punishment to help change a criminals mindset and turn them into a better person who will benefit society instead.
- 5. A criminal act against a person or a person's property by an offender motivated by a prejudice
