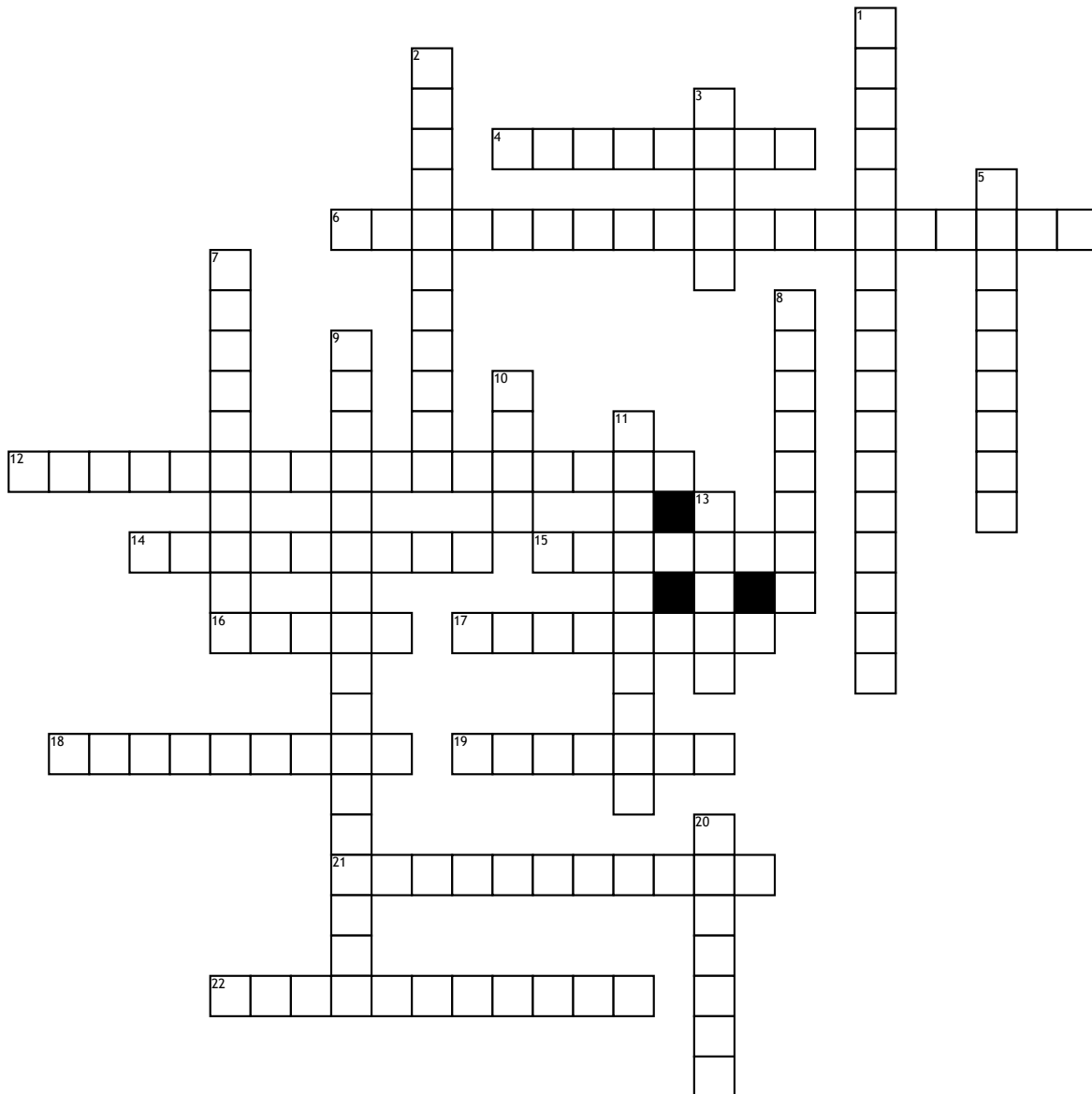


# Criminal Fines and Fees
