Criminal Fines and Fees Terms

1. The amount of fine imposed as punishment for a specific crime or as a condition of probation. The Court may allow jail time or community service in lieu of it. A. Fees and Assessments
2. An amount that is statutorily added to a fine at a rate of 20%. B. Court Operations Assessment
3. An amount statutorily added to a fine that is calculated at a rate multiplied by every \$10 fine or portion thereof. C. Community Service
4. Custody credits are converted to a dollar value of \$_____ a day, unless a different amount is indicated by the Judicial Officer. D. Probation Revocation Fine
5. A mandatory fine imposed on all misdemeanor and felony convictions that is distributed to a state fund that provides assistance to crime victims. E. Crim. Conviction Assessment
6. A fine that is imposed and suspended on all probationary cases and only becomes effective upon revocation of probation. F. Penalty Assessment
7. An assessment imposed as to each convicted criminal offense except for parking violations. Previously known as Court Security Fee. G. Laboratory Service Fund
8. A fee imposed as to each convicted criminal offense except for parking violations. (Misdemeanor and Felony-\$30/count. Infraction-\$35/count.) H. prison
9. Rate of conversion: 1 hour = minimum wage. 1 day = 8 hours. I. Community Labor
10. Rate of conversion: 1 day = \$125.00 J. Restitution Fund Fine
11. After sentencing, this balance is refunded to the depositor within 24 hours or applied to fines and fees if authorized. K. 125.00
12. Amounts imposed by statute to fund a particular organization or program associated with the crime committed, or to reimburse the Court, attorneys, DMV, probation department, and/or jail. L. DUI Restitution Fund
13. If a defendant is in _____, penalty assessments may be waived pursuant to PC 1464(d). M. Criminal Surcharge
14. The rate of penalty assessments is determined by the _____ N. Base Fine
