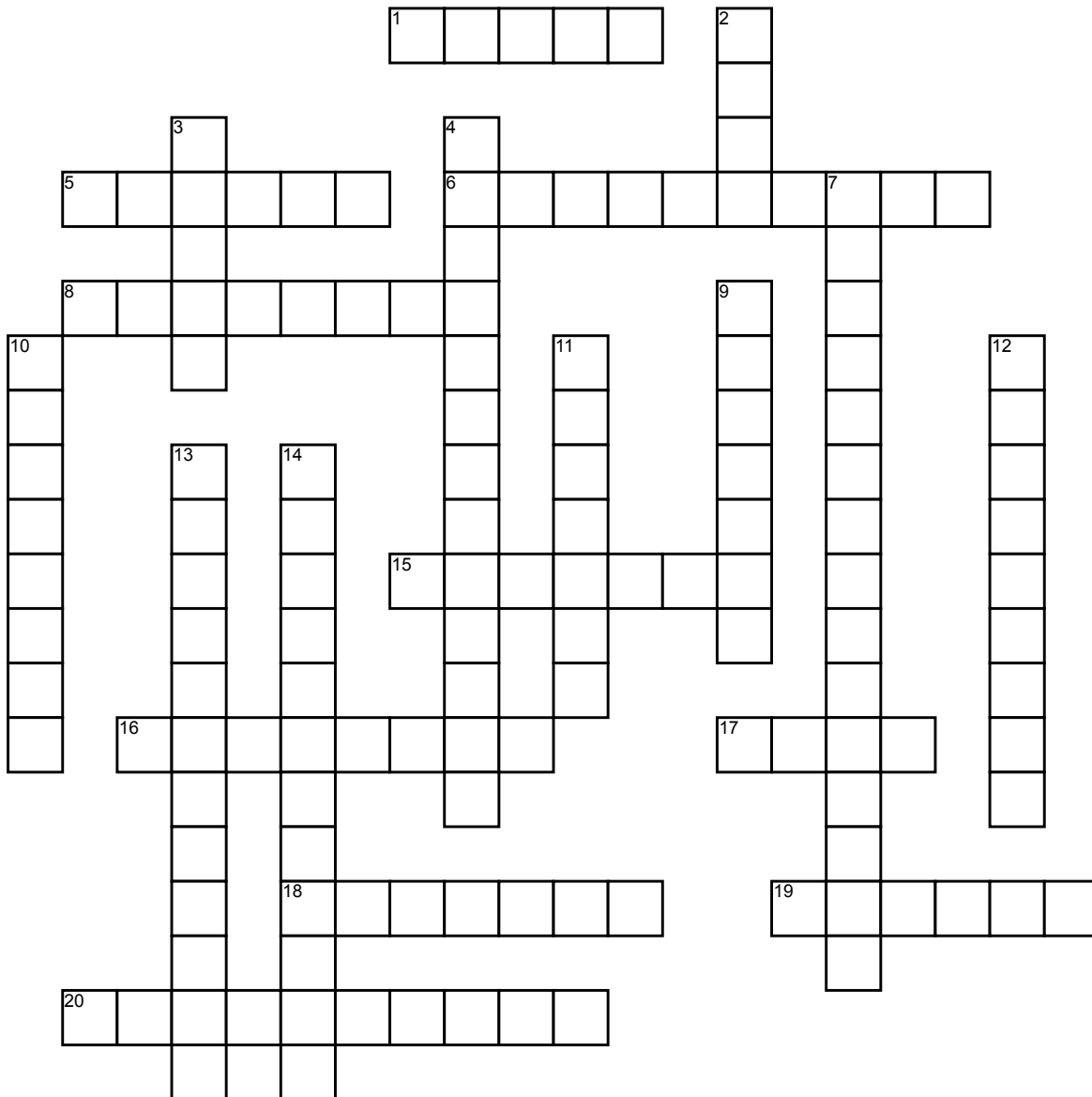


# Crossword, Good Luck!
