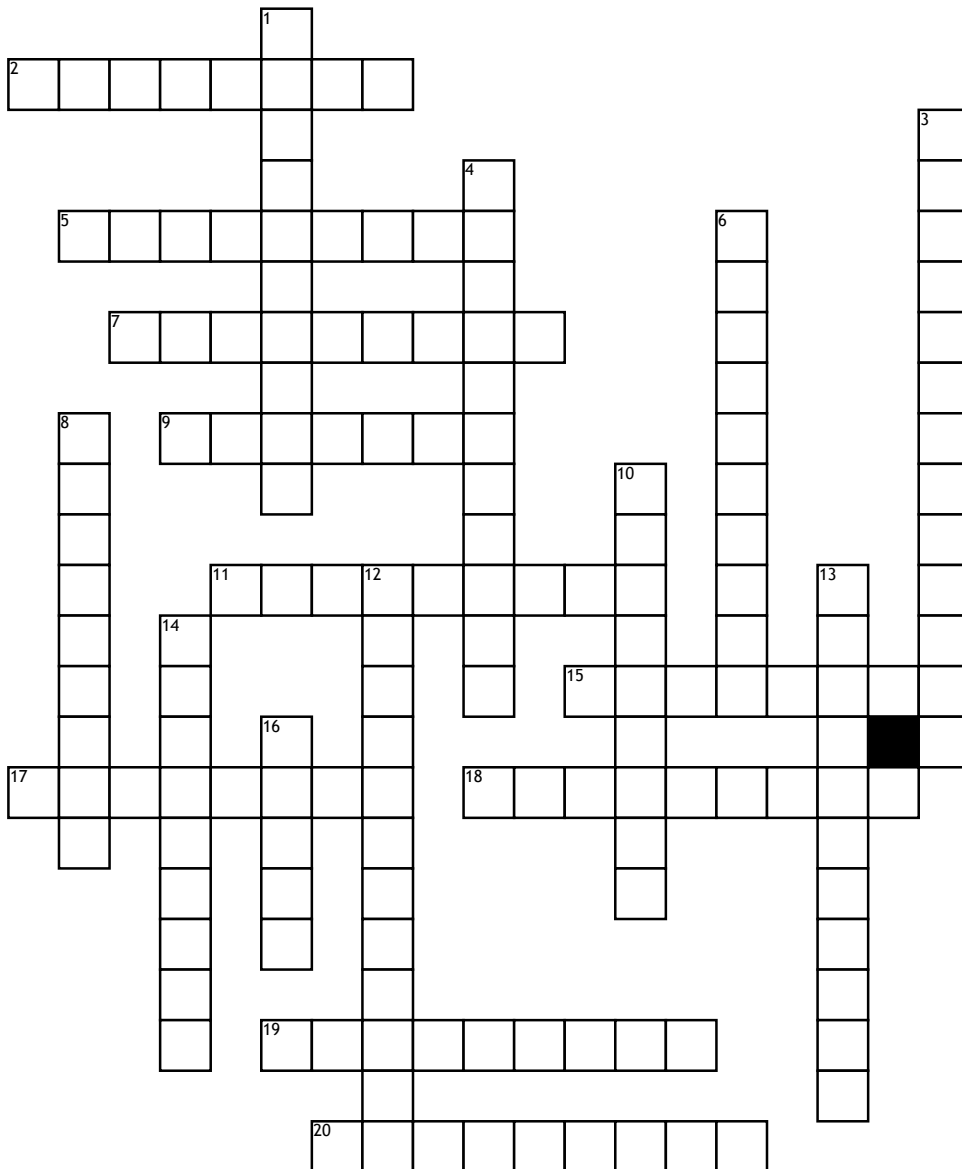


# Crossword Medical Terms

- 5. a type of cell within the body capable of engulfing and absorbing bacteria and other small cells and particles
- 7. the production or development of an ovum
- 9. a benign tumor formed from glandular structures in epithelial tissue
- 11. inflammation of the walls of a vein
- 15. production of abnormally large volumes of dilute urine
- 17. causing increased passing of urine

- 18. the dissolution or disruption of cells, especially by an external agent
- 19. inflammation of the intestine, especially the small intestine, usually accompanied by diarrhea
- 20. having or composed of parts that are similar in number or position

- 1. an instrument which measures the working speed of an engine (especially in a road vehicle), typically in revolutions per minute
- 3. Having a broad flat nose
- 4. the membrane enclosing the heart, consisting of an outer fibrous layer and an inner double layer of serous membrane

- 6. the surgical opening or puncture of a vein in order to withdraw blood or introduce a fluid, or (historically) as part of the procedure of letting blood
- 8. a benign outgrowth of cartilaginous tissue on a bone
- 10. the study of the microscopic structure of tissues
- 12. inflammation of the endocardium
- 13. an instrument for recording heart muscle activity, such as an electrocardiograph
- 14. exceptionally large red blood cell
