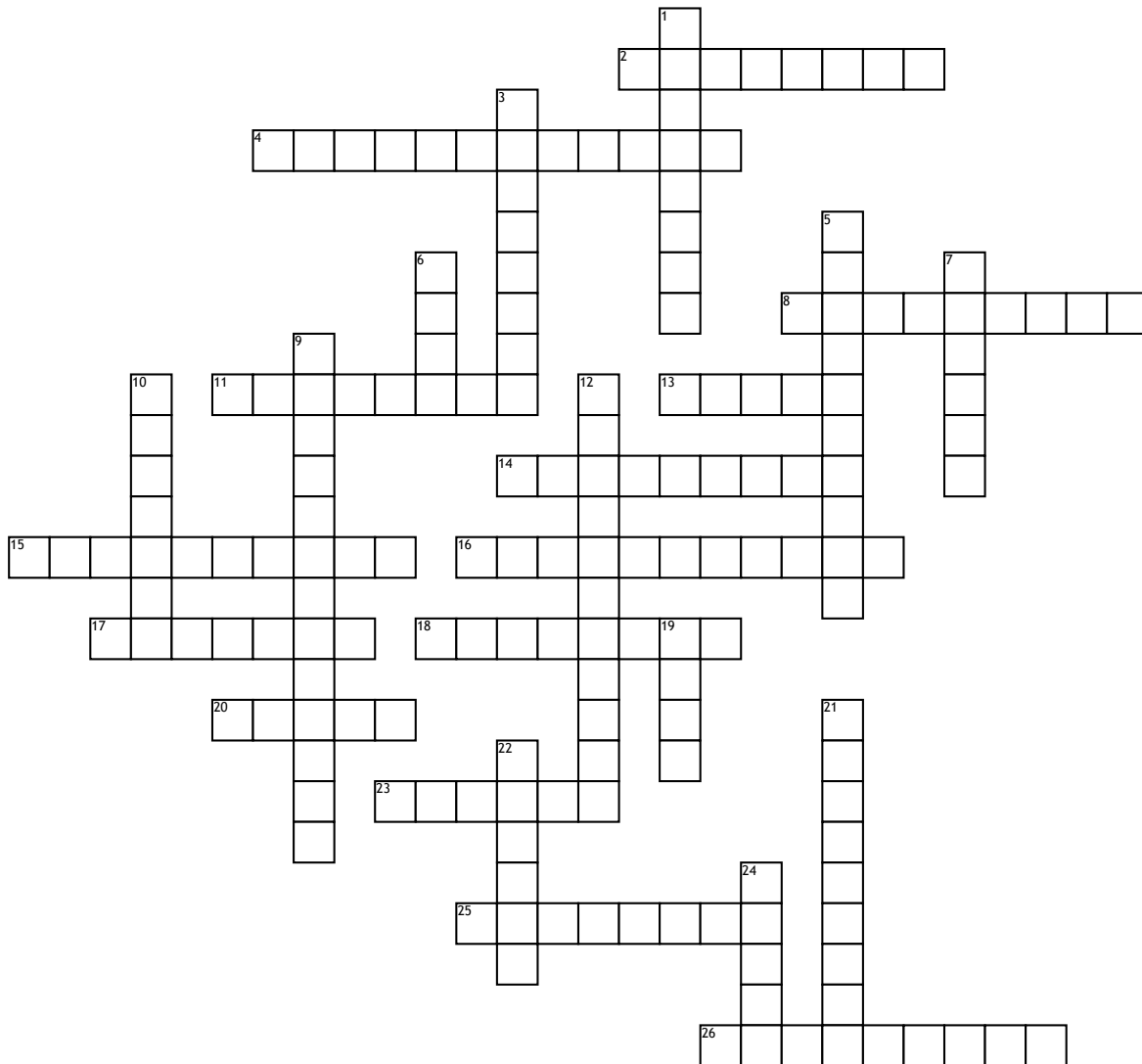


# Crossword No. 3
