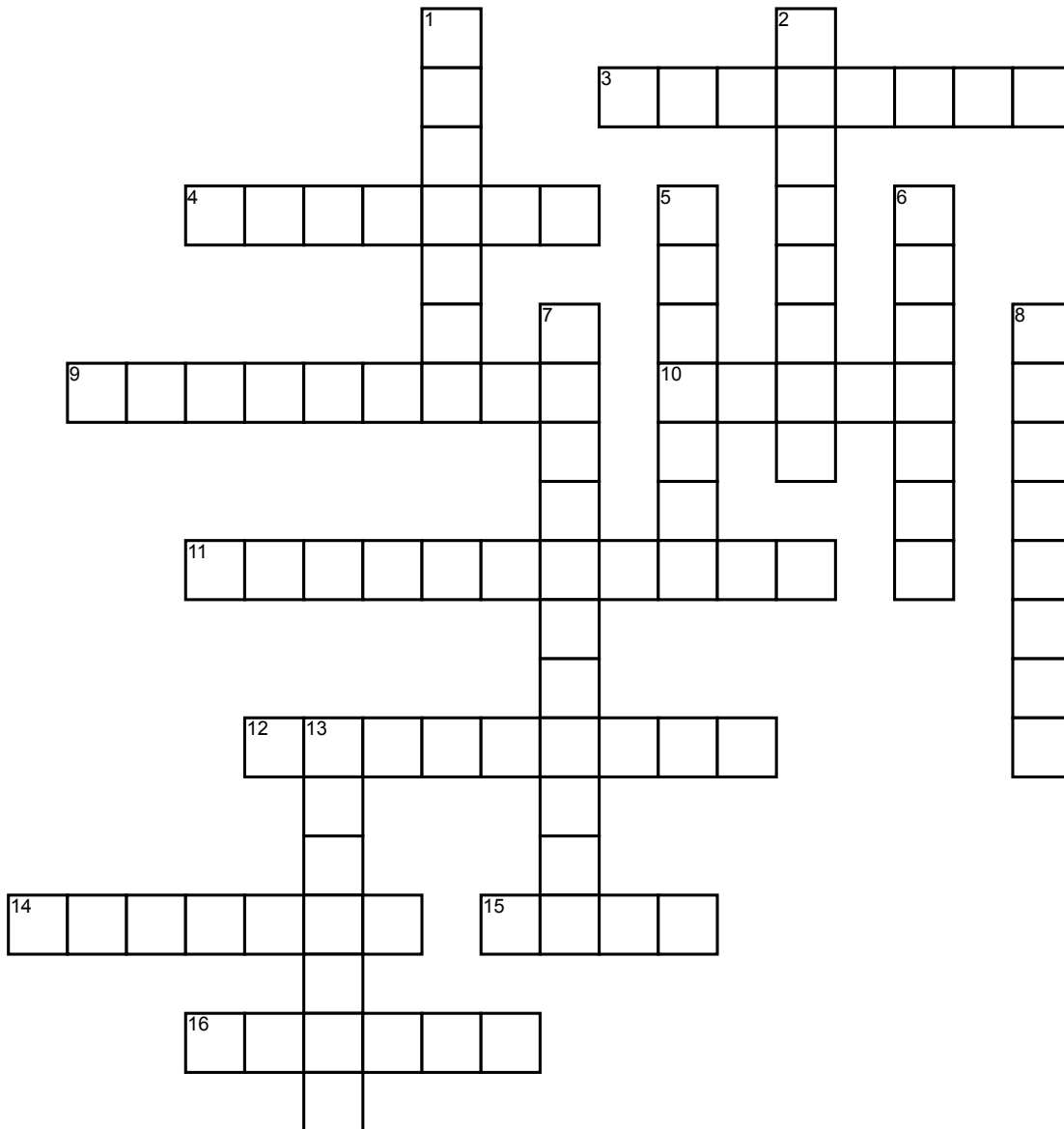


Crossword Puzzle: Gout, Alzheimers and Parkinsons
