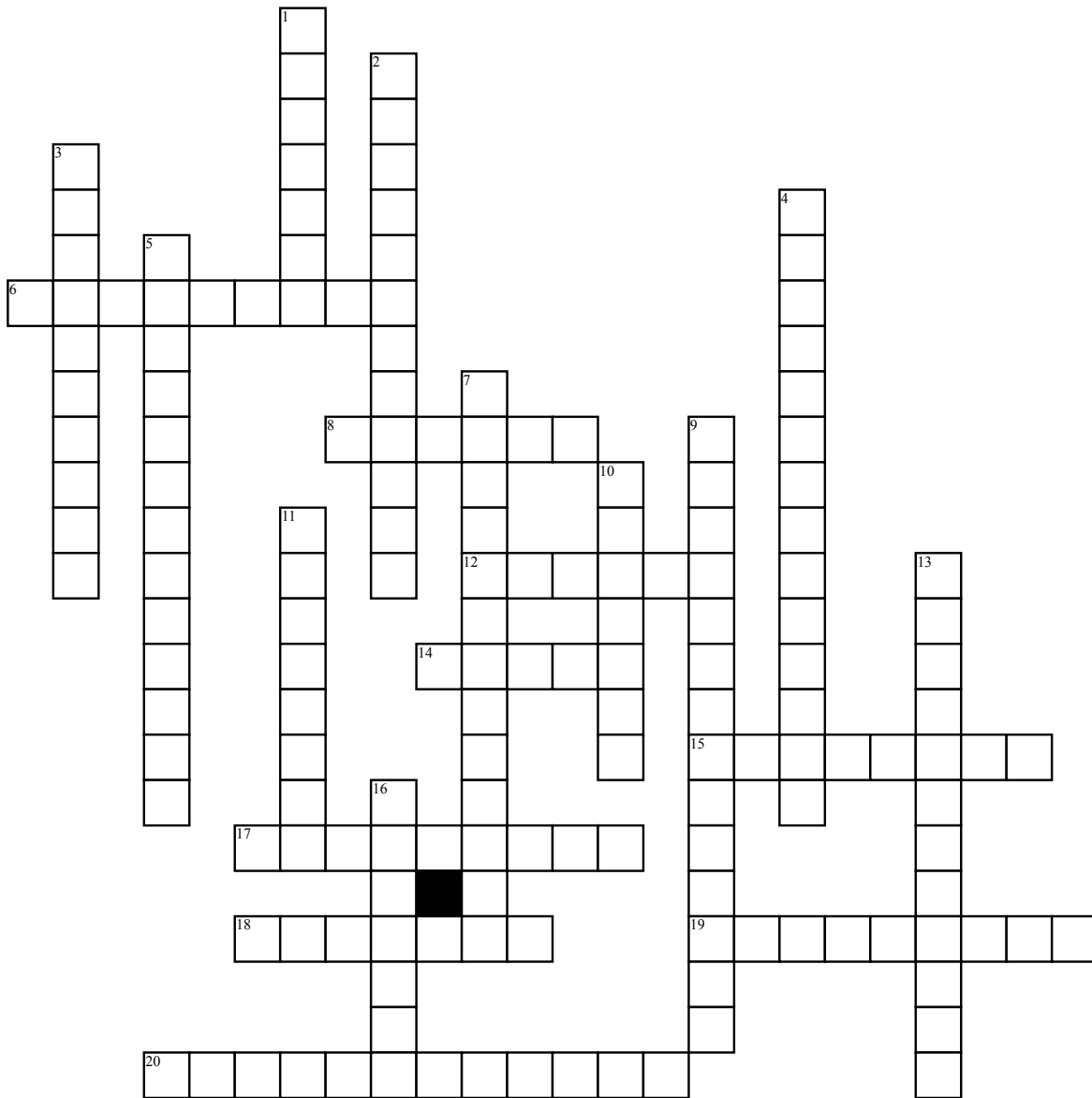


Crossword Puzzle: Poetry



Across

- 6. the repetition of the same vowel sounds among words
- 8. a grouped set of lines in a poem, set apart with a line of space
- 12. a stanza or poem that contains eight lines
- 14. a single line of a poem
- 15. five line poem or stanzas with rhyme scheme; AABBA
- 17. rhymes at the ends of lines
- 18. a pair of two lines in a poem that contains end rhymes
- 19. consecutive lines, stanza, or entire poem has the same end rhyme

- 20. words whose sounds imitate their meaning

Down

- 1. phrases or lines of poetry that are repeated in the poem
- 2. the repetition of initial consonant sounds in a series of words
- 3. the repetition of the same consonant sounds among words (not limited to initial sounds)
- 4. rhymes as ABAB, CDCD, & EFEF
- 5. words whose final syllables have the exact same sound

- 7. rhyming scheme where 1st & 4th lines rhyme and 2nd & 3rd lines rhyme; ABBA
- 9. rhymes within lines
- 10. the author's use of vivid and descriptive details that appeal to the human senses
- 11. a stanza or poem that contains four lines
- 13. words whose final syllables almost rhyme
- 16. rhyme scheme that repeats with three lines; AAA BBB
