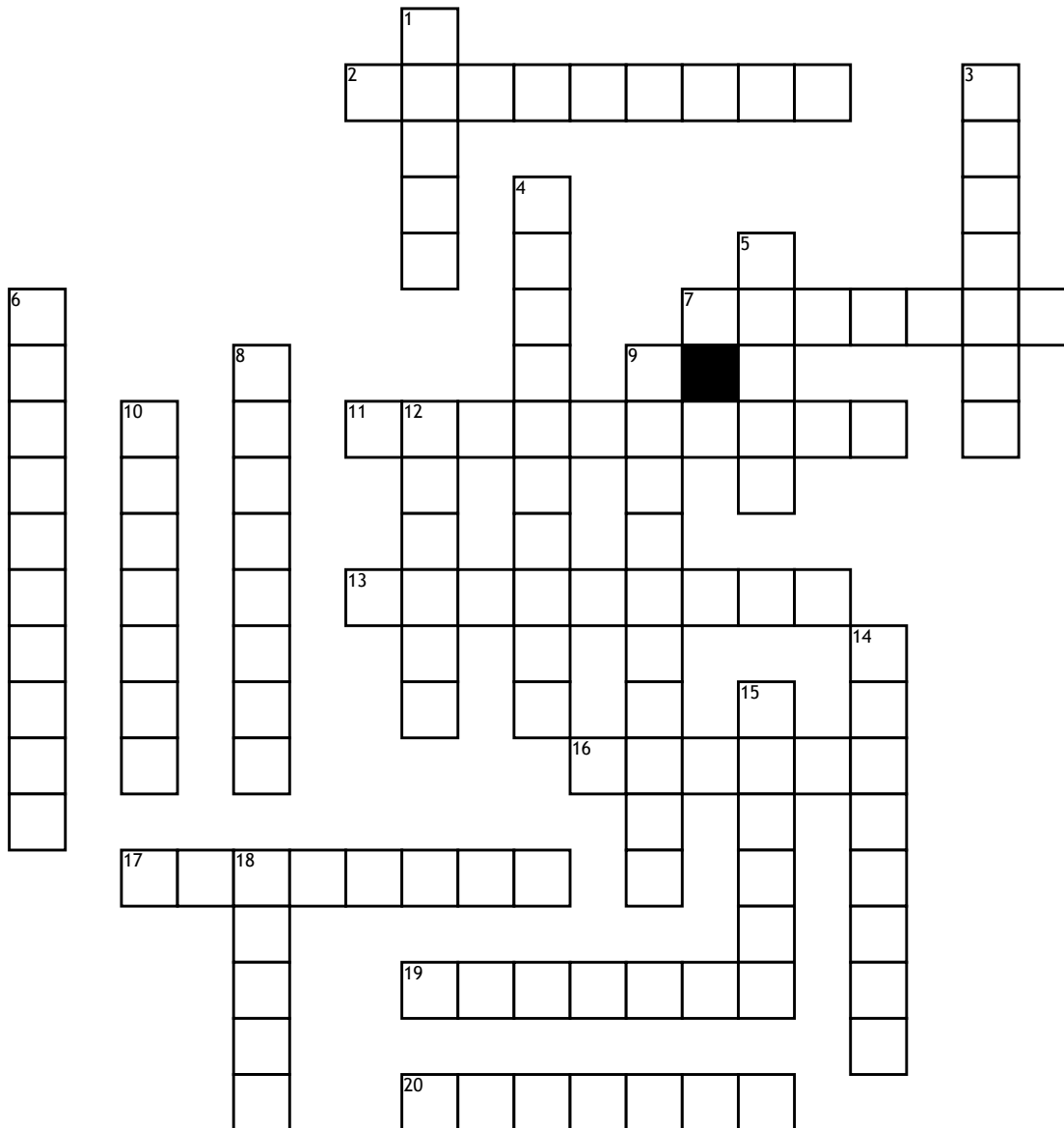


Crossword Puzzle

2. Harsh sounds; noisy or disturbing sounds

 11. A large room that accommodates an audience, often for meetings or performances
 13. The repetition of similar vowel sounds in the stressed syllables of successive words
 16. A poem with 14 lines that usually sounds like one of several conventional rhyme schemes
 17. To vibrate or repeat in sound; to correspond harmoniously
 19. State or condition of touching

20. Touching at a single point but not intersecting; a sudden digression or change of topic within a conversation; no longer touching on the subject

1. A sharp taste or flavor immediately sensed upon touch with the tongue
 3. Touching in a snarl; connected together in a disorderly way
 4. Adjacent; touching; sharing an edge or boundary
 5. The sound portion of a broadcast
 6. A record player; a machine that reproduces sound

8. Able to be touched
 9. Capable of transmitting an illness, infection, or disease by touch
 10. Perceptible to the touch; used for feeling
 12. Words or music produced by more than one person that sounds as if from one voice
 14. To twist together; making it complicated to free two things from touching
 15. Whole; not damaged by touch
 18. Echolocation; a system using transmitted and reflected underwater sound waves to detect and locate submerged objects
