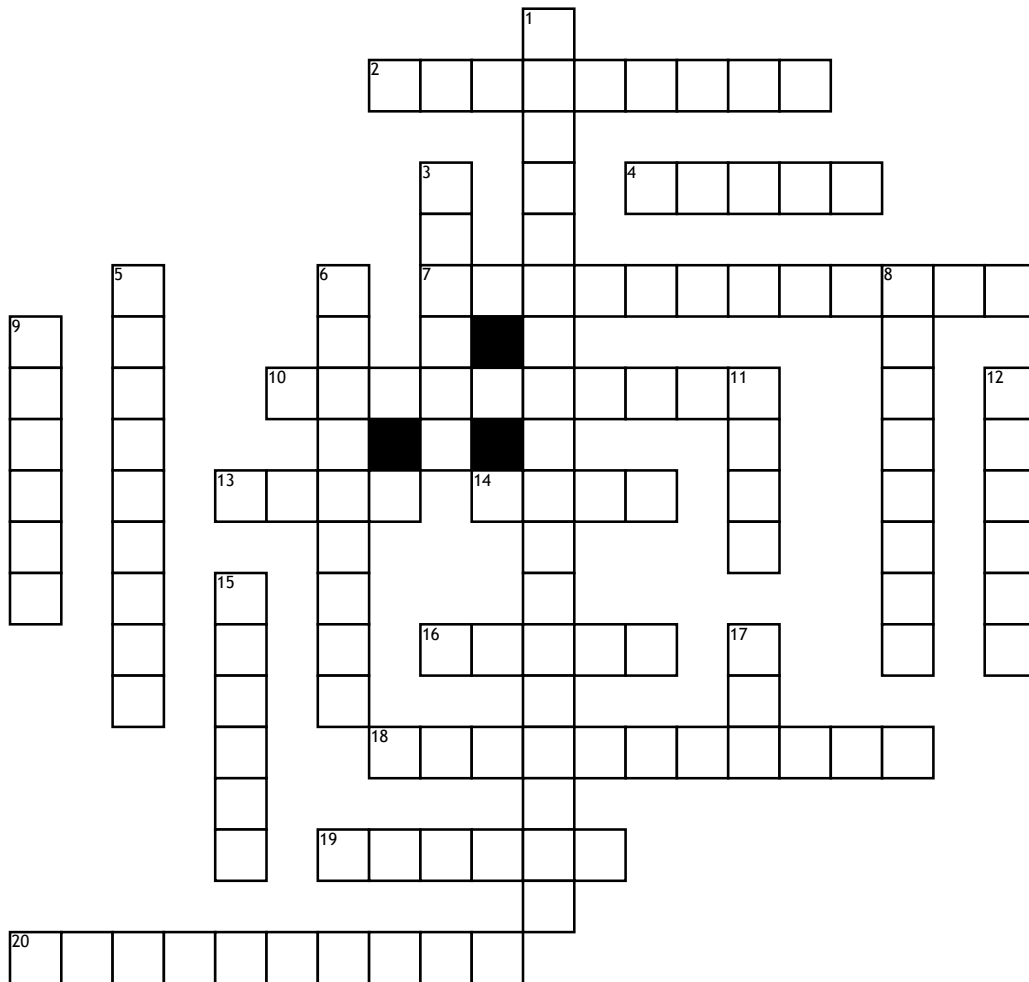


Crossword by Natalya Butler
