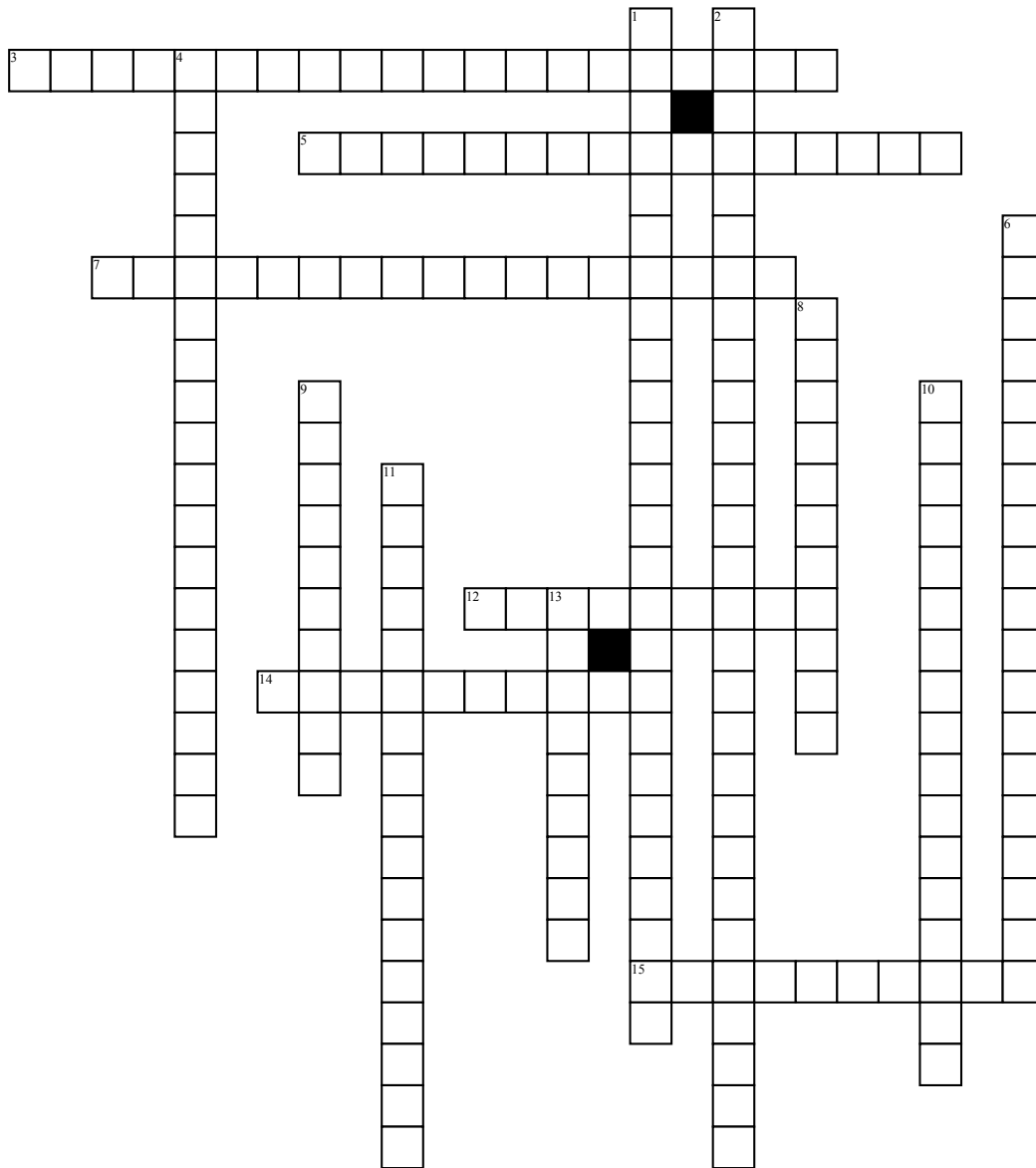


# Crossword for Apush
