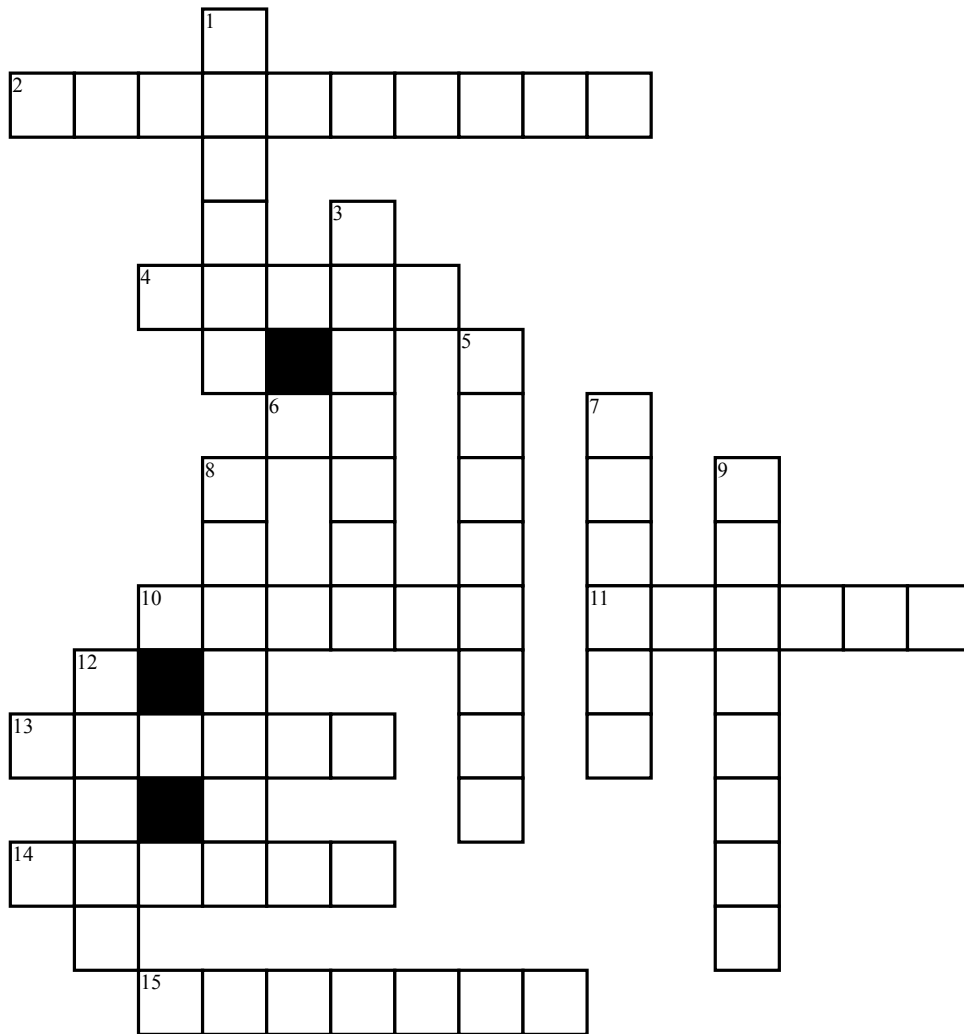


Crossword of the Day
