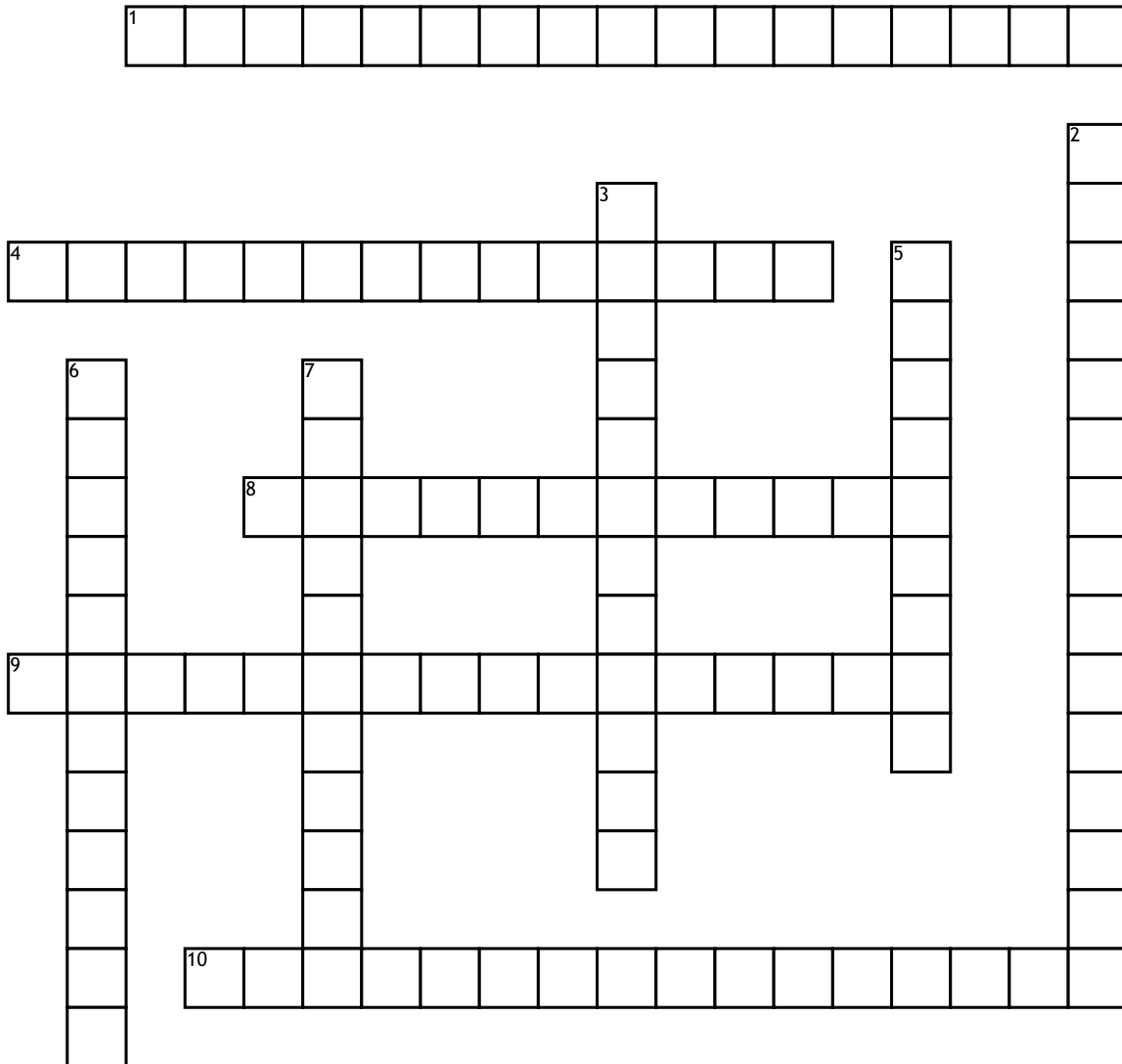


Crossword puzzle: By Yanni T.
