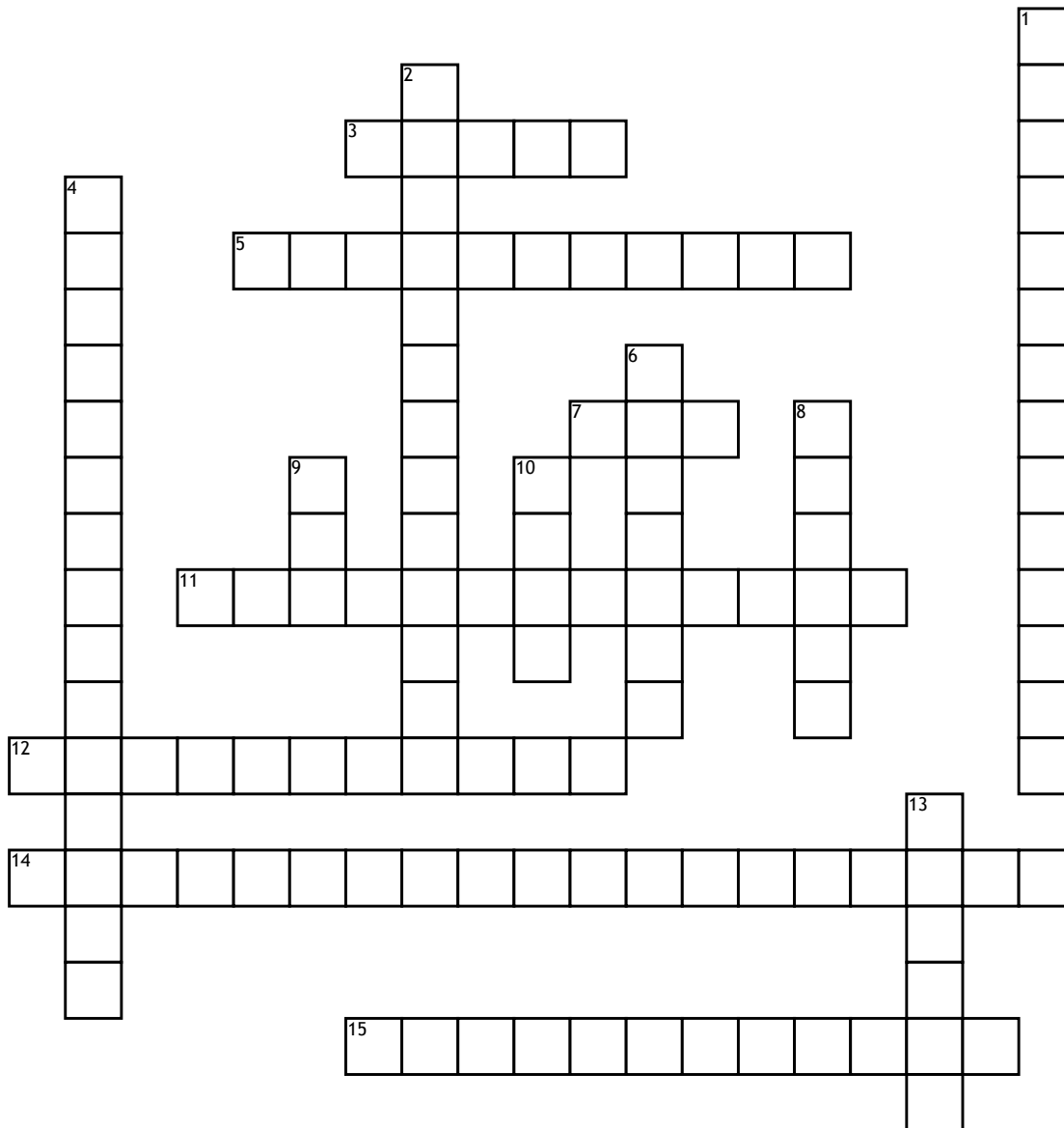

9. An acting crowd that becomes violent

10. A frenzied crowd without any particular purpose or goal where people are unorganized
