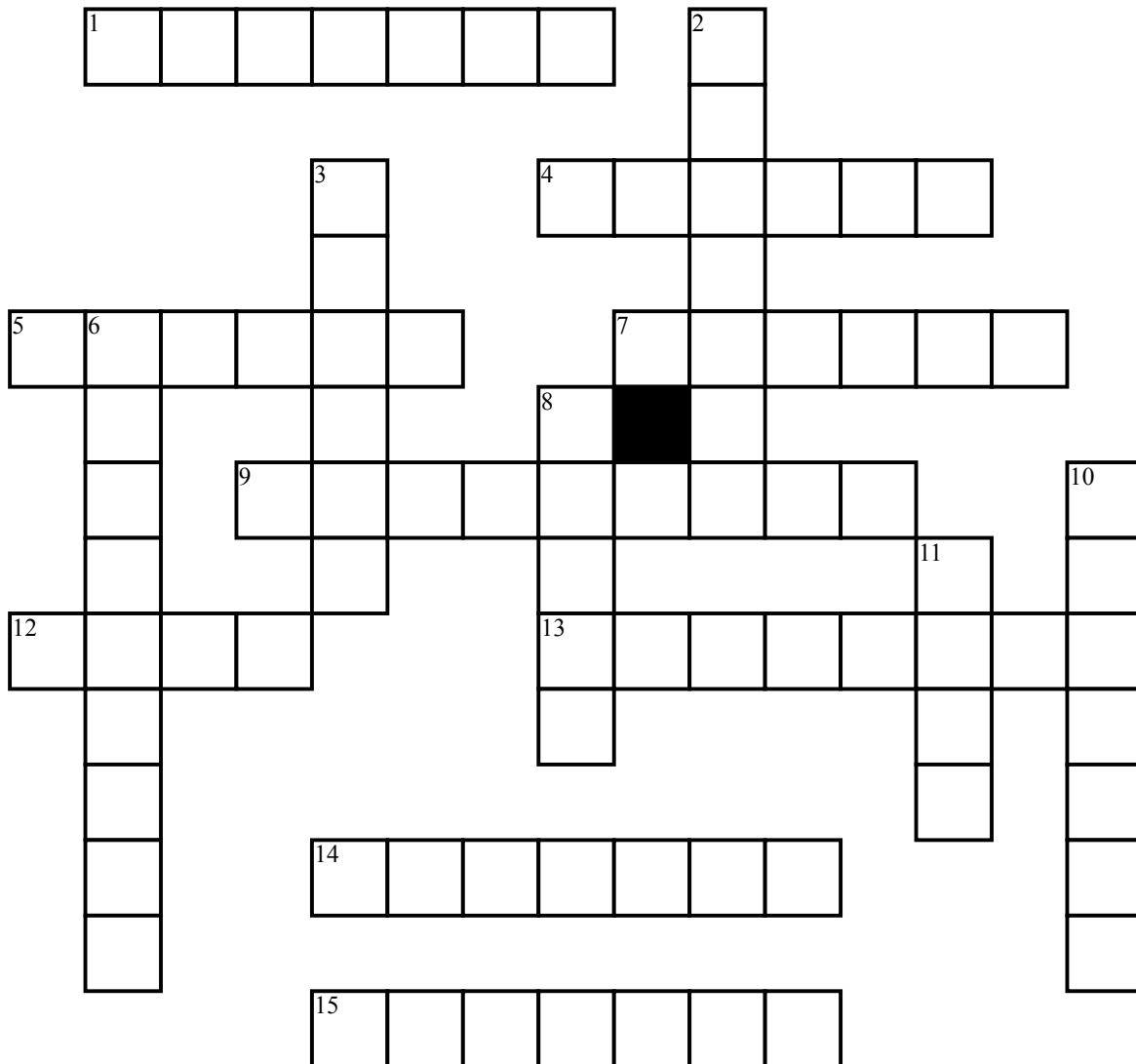


# Cry Blue Murder
