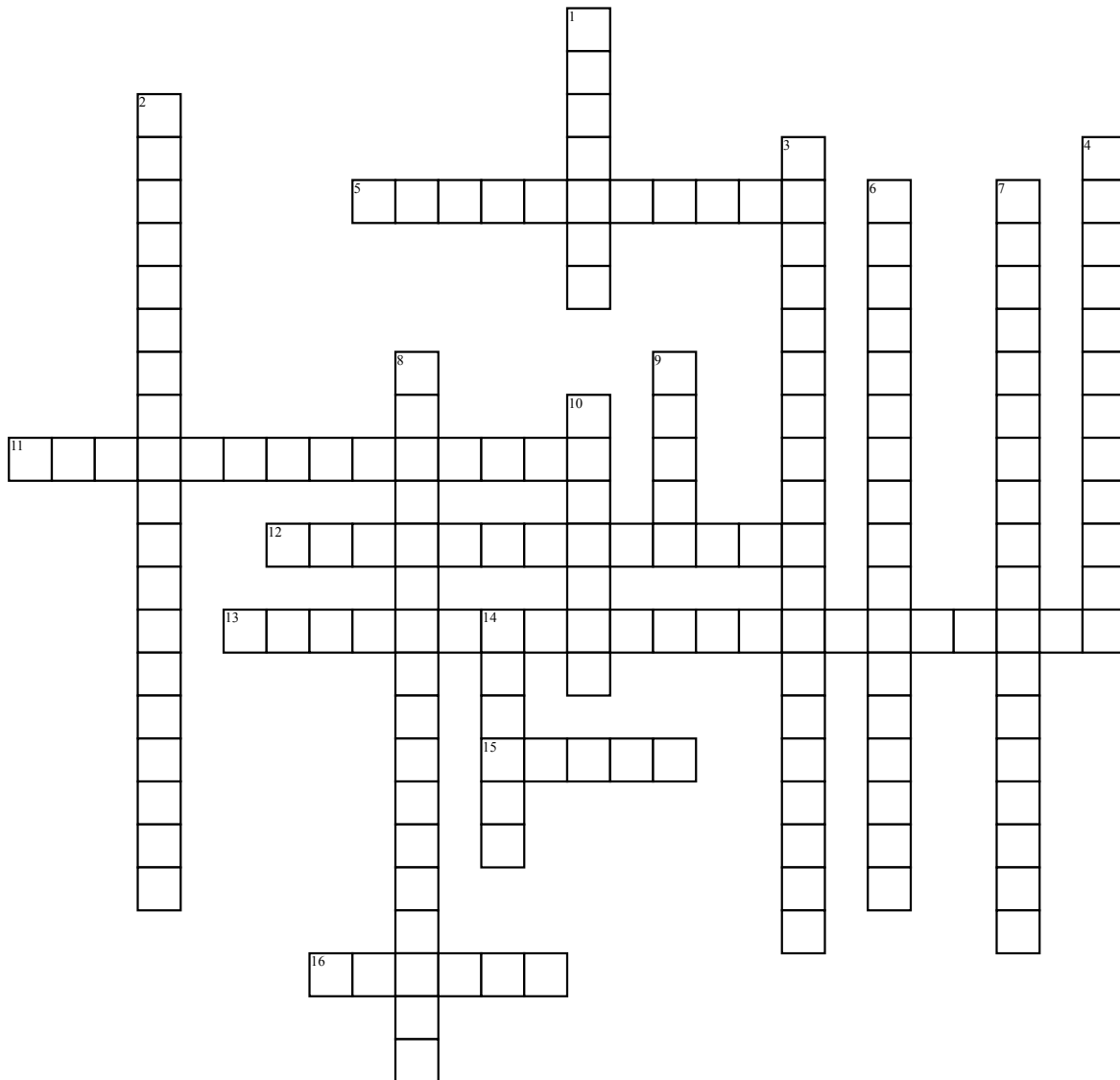


# Cultural Patterns and Processes

- 1. The body of customary beliefs, social forms and material traits that together constitute a groups distinctive tradition
- 2. The rapid, widespread diffusion of a feature or tend throughout a population
- 3. The spread of feature or trend through bodily movement of people from one place to another
- 4. The process of giving up cultural traditions and adopting the social customs of the dominant culture of a place
- 6. The spread of an underlying principle even though a specific characteristics is rejected

- 7. The spread of a feature or trend among people from one area to another in an additive process
- 8. An approach to geography that emphasizes the relationship among social and physical phenomena in a particular study area
- 9. A repetitive act performed by a particular individual
- 10. The contribution of a location's distinctive physical features to the way food tastes
- 14. The frequent repetition of an act, to the extent that it becomes characteristic of the group of people performing the act
