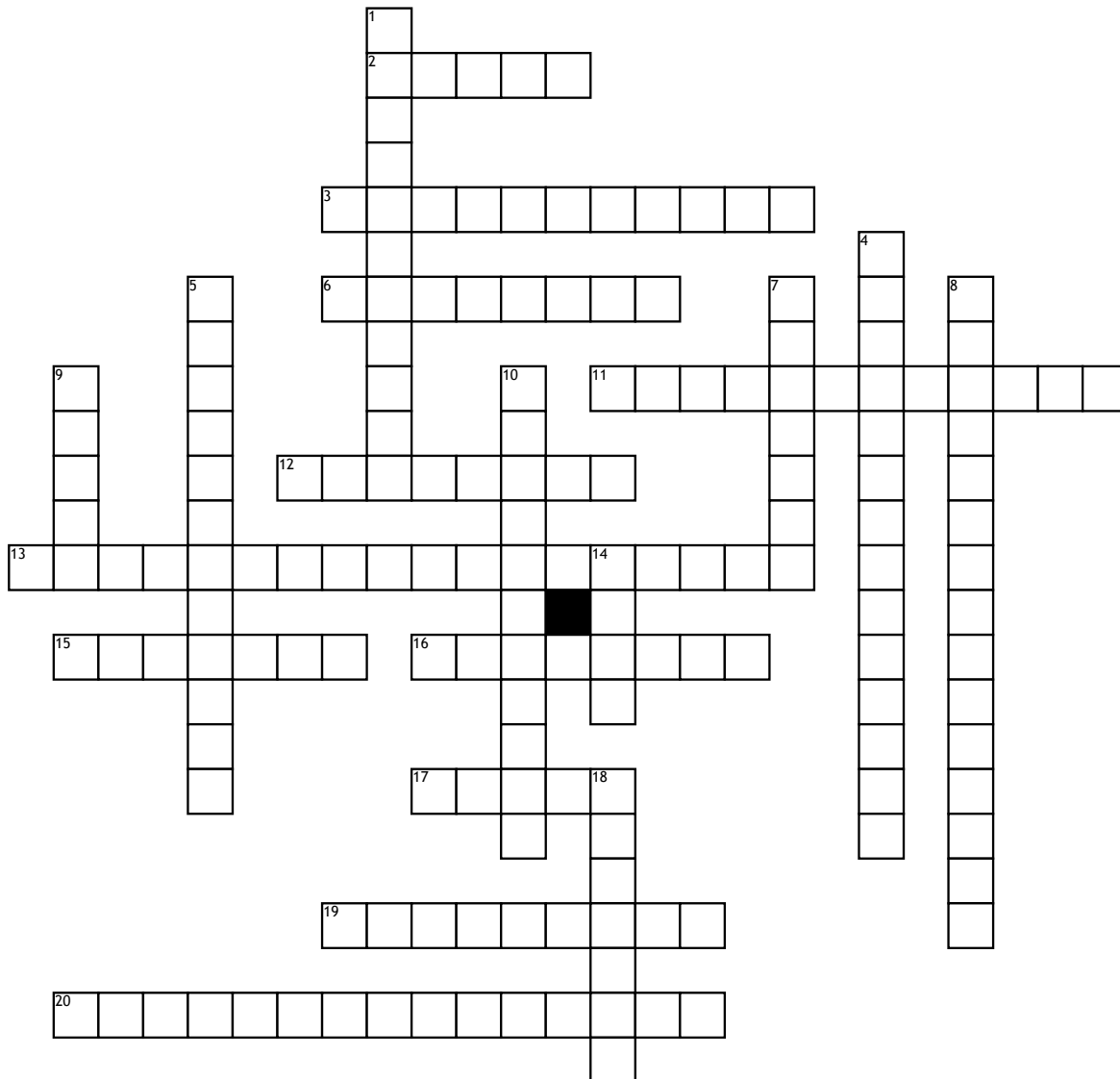


Culture Crossword
