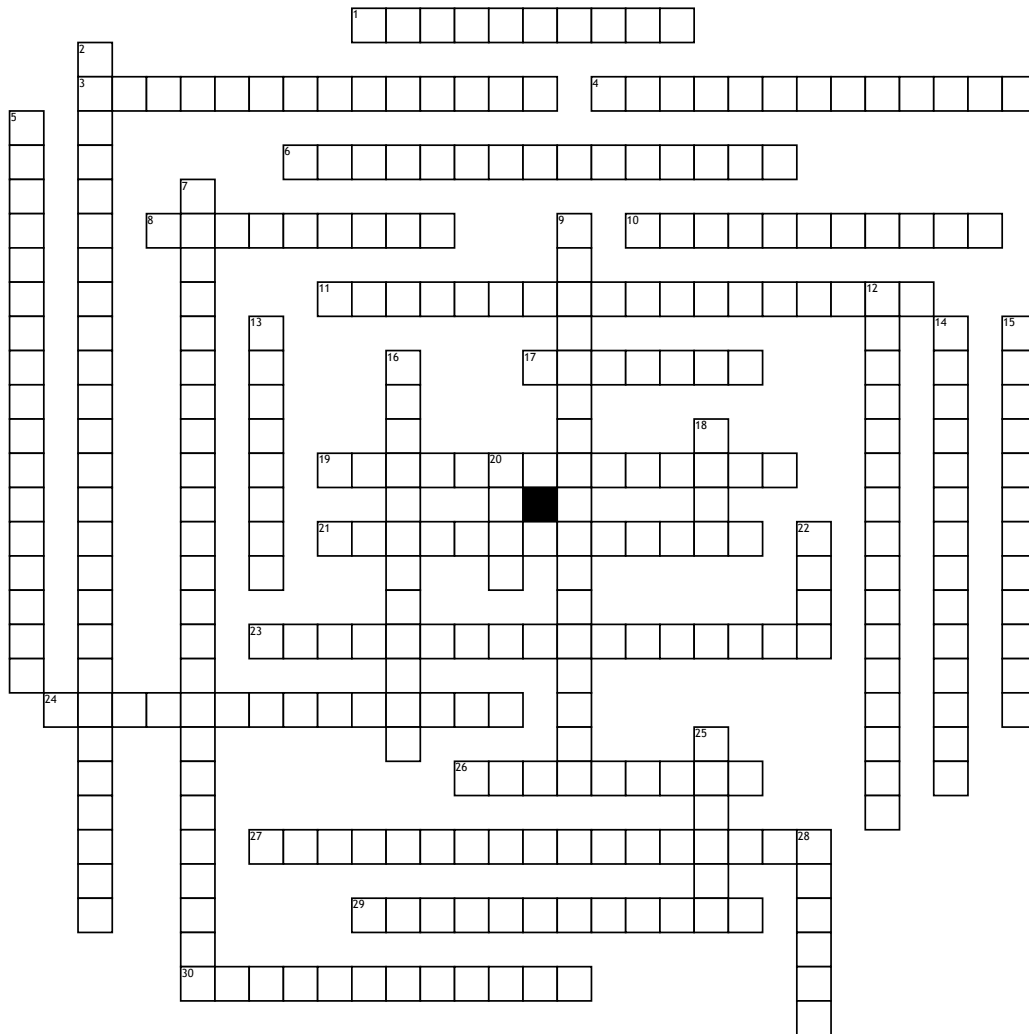


Culture Crossword Puzzle
