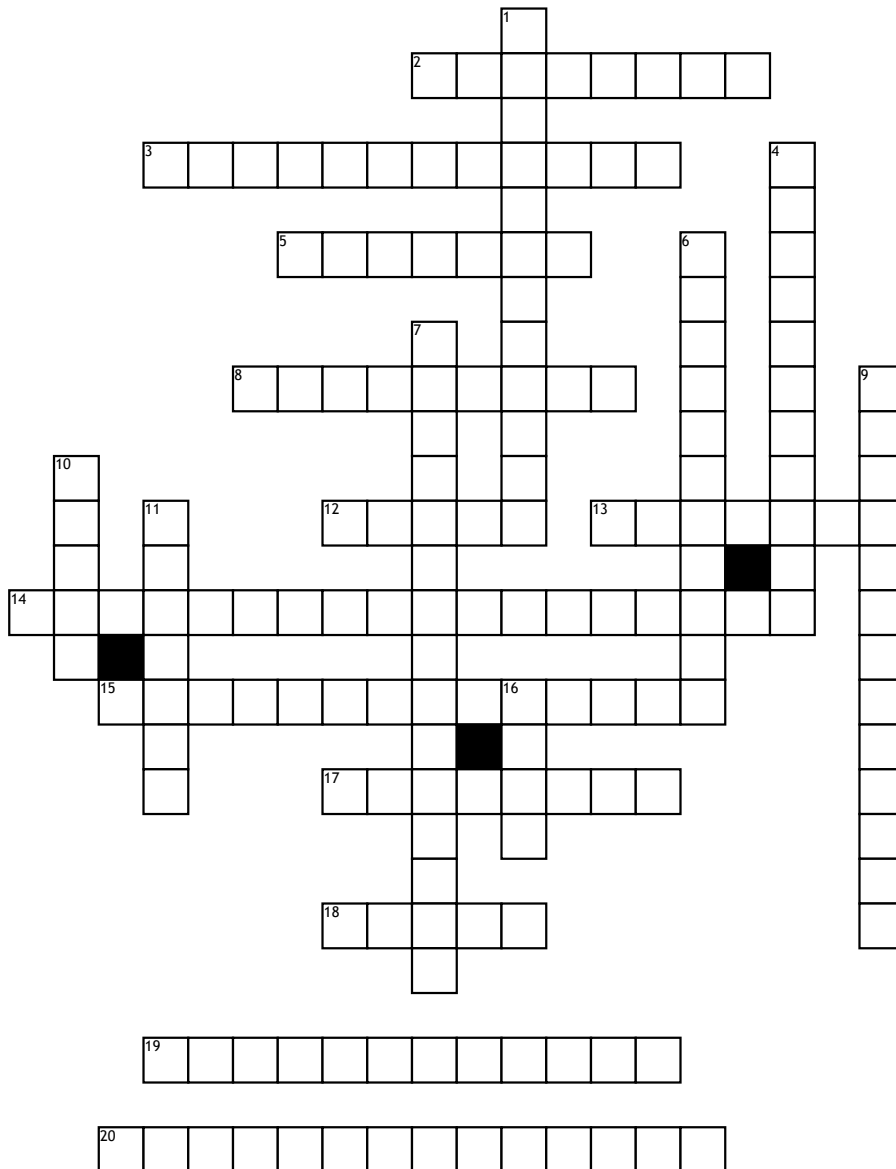


Culture and Society Crossword

- 2. A system of verbal and sometimes written representations that are culturally specific and convey meaning about the world.
- 3. Referring to the values and norms that a society professes to believe
- 5. People who interact in such a way as to share a common culture.

- 12. The agreed upon expectations and rules by which a culture guides the behavior of its members in any given situation.
