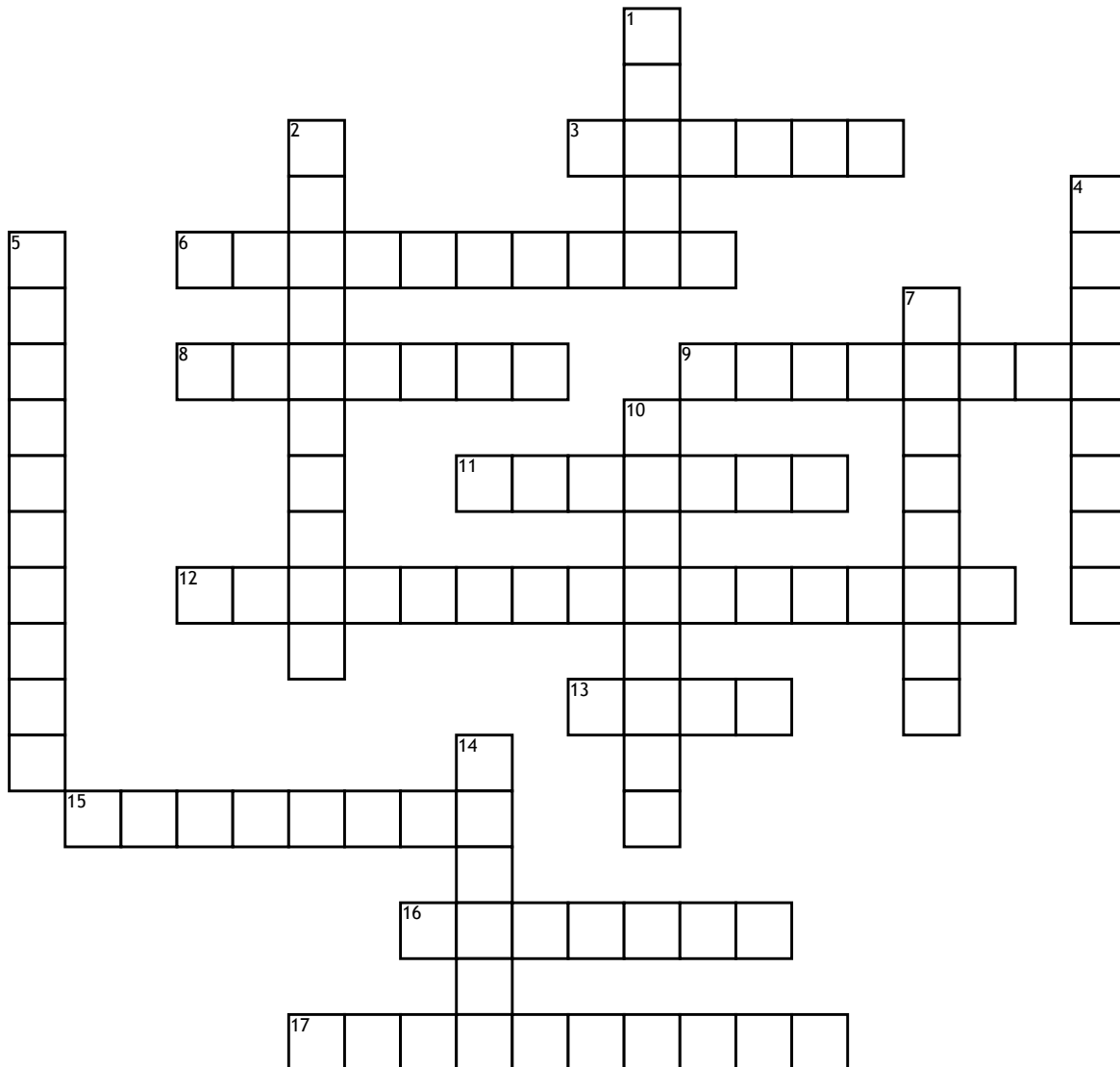


Cyber Security 2018 Cross Word Puzzle
