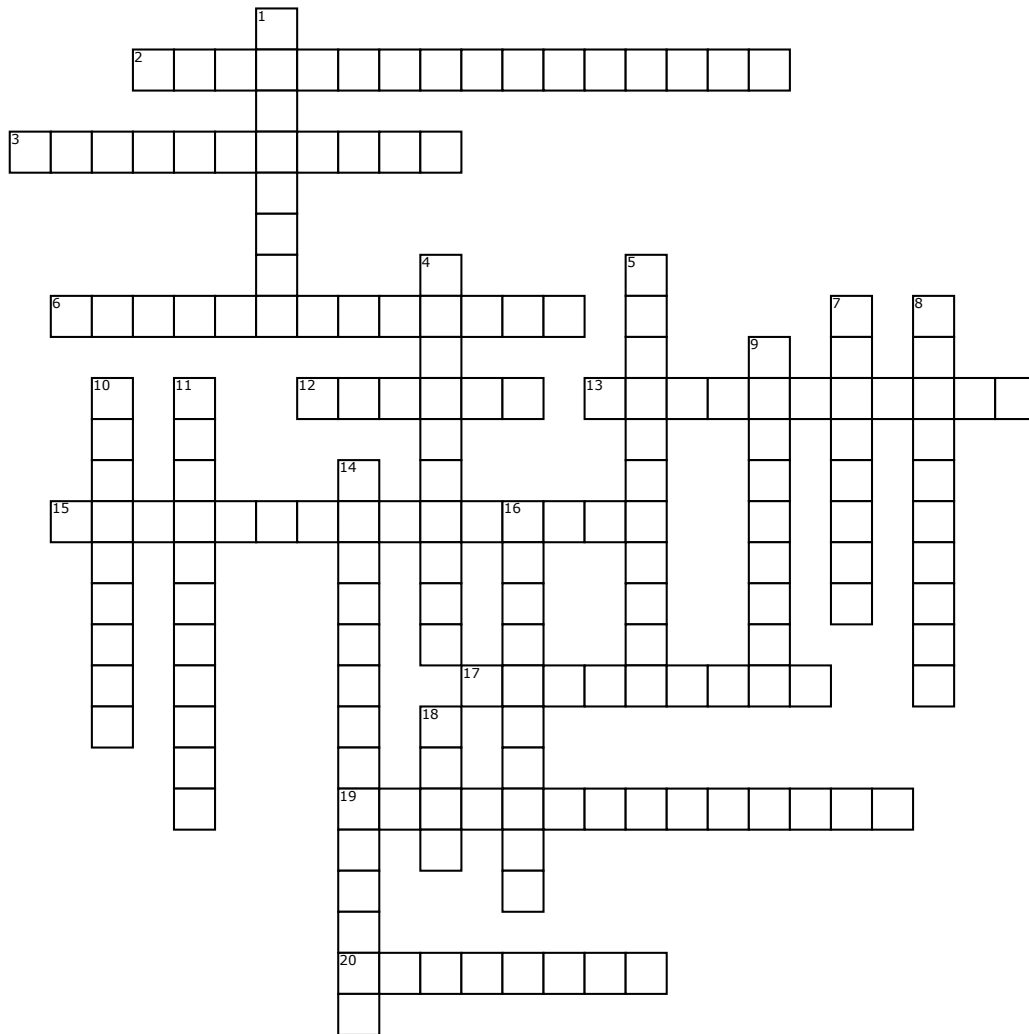

**3.** Rim built on the base plate to register vertical dimension and occlusal relationship of the mandibular and maxillary arches  
**6.** Process of using fingers to contour a closer adaption of the margins of an impression while still in the mouth  
**12.** Parts of a full or partial denture that extends from the teeth to the border of the denture  
**13.** Surgical shaping and smoothing of the margins of the tooth socket after extraction of the tooth  
**15.** Having the jaws in a position that produces a centrally related occlusion

**17.** Metal skeleton of a reovable partial denture

**19.** A removable prosthesis that replaces teeth in the same arch

**20.** Clear plastic tray that represents the alveolus as it should appear after teeth have been extracted
