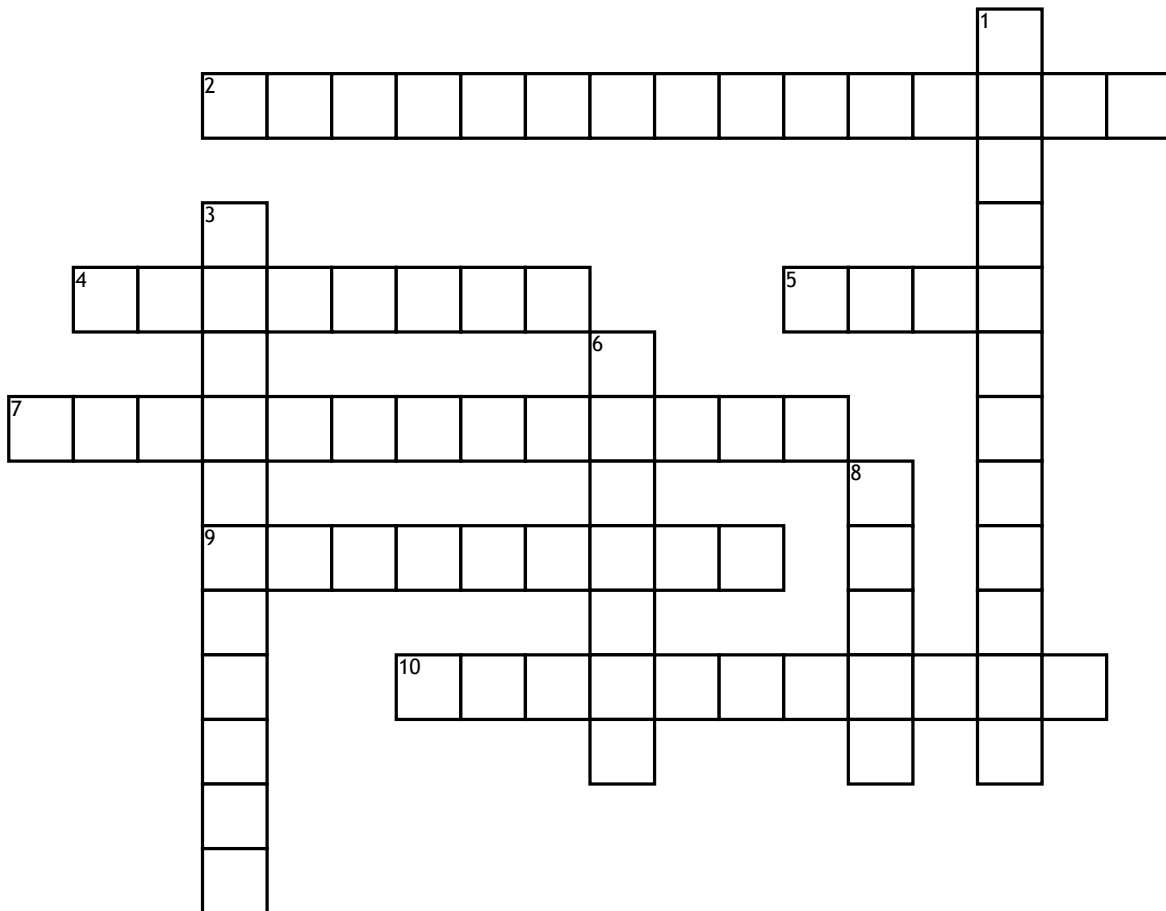


DDH



Across

- 2. Plays a factor in the cause of DDH
- 4. May develop a limp when walking
- 5. Diagnostic tool used to help diagnose DDH
- 7. Adjustable chest halter that abducts the legs
- 9. If a hip is fully dislocated or the subluxation is severe, an infant may be placed immediately in a frog-leg, A-line cast to maintain an externally rotated hip position

- 10. Babies with this diagnosis are at a higher risk for DDH due to lack of room of growth in utero

Down

- 1. is improper formation and function of the hip socket
- 3. May present with activity related groin pain
- 6. Physically present with one leg longer than the other
- 8. Are 4-5 times more likely to develop DDH due to ligament laxity
