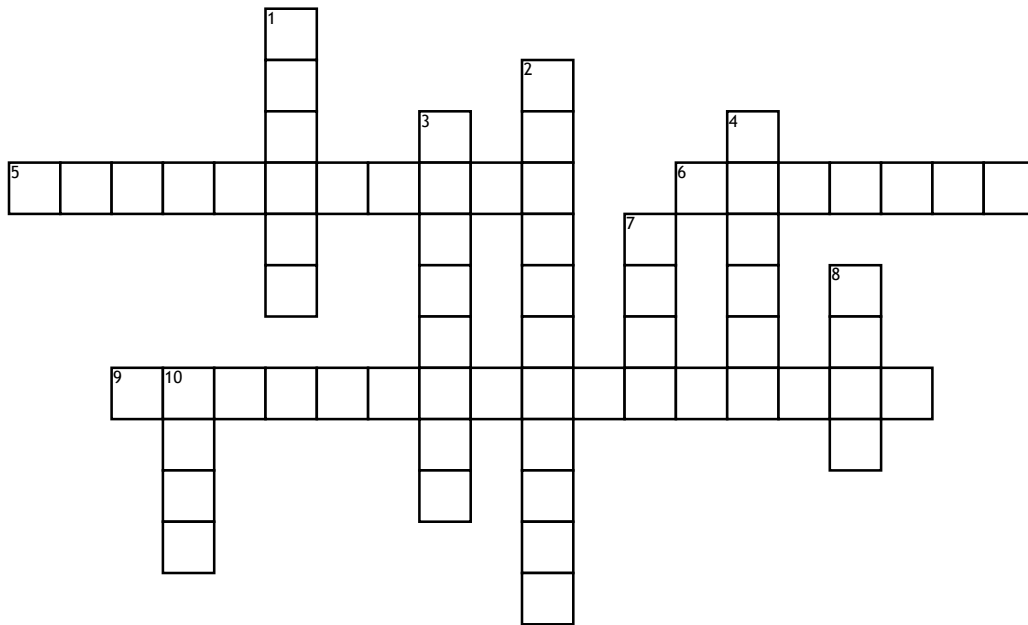


DNA Fingerprinting



Across

- 5. an imprint made by ridge patterns on the tip of a finger
- 6. fine powders used in a dusting for a fingerprint made as indentions in soft material, fresh paints, puty, or wax
- 9. visible impressins left at a scene can be used to link the observed marks to a class of objects

Down

- 1. fingerprint patterns with at least two deltas and a core

- 2. fingerprint made by the deposit of perspiration or body oils; invisible to the naked eye
- 3. in descriptions of fingerprints, ridge characteristics
- 4. liquids can sink in when dropped onto porous
- 7. in a fingerprint, area found near the center of all and whorls patterns
- 8. fingerprint pattern with one or more ridges entering from one side, curving, then going out on the same side
- 10. the least common and simplest fingerprint patterns
