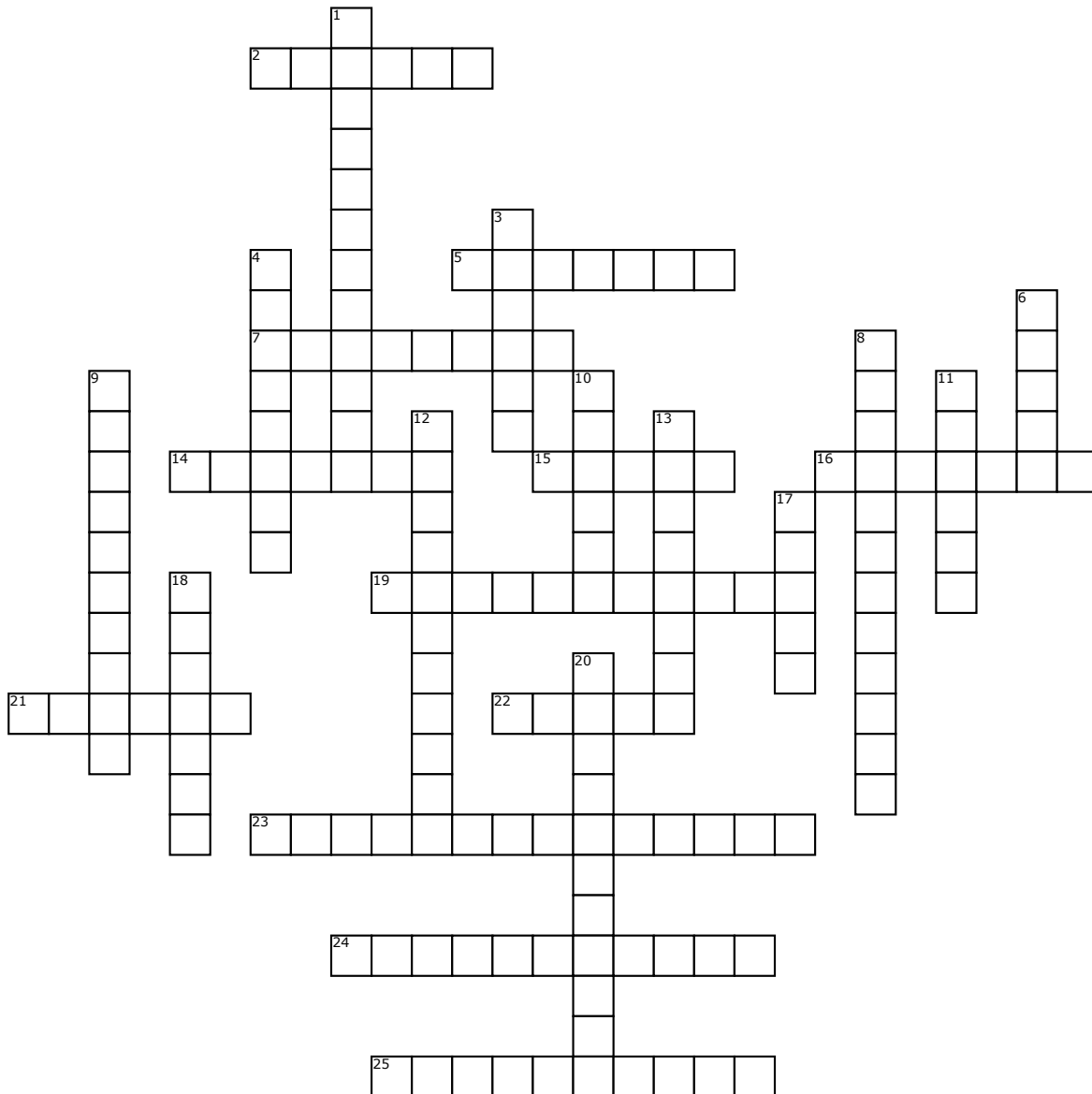


Dark Thicket Crossword
