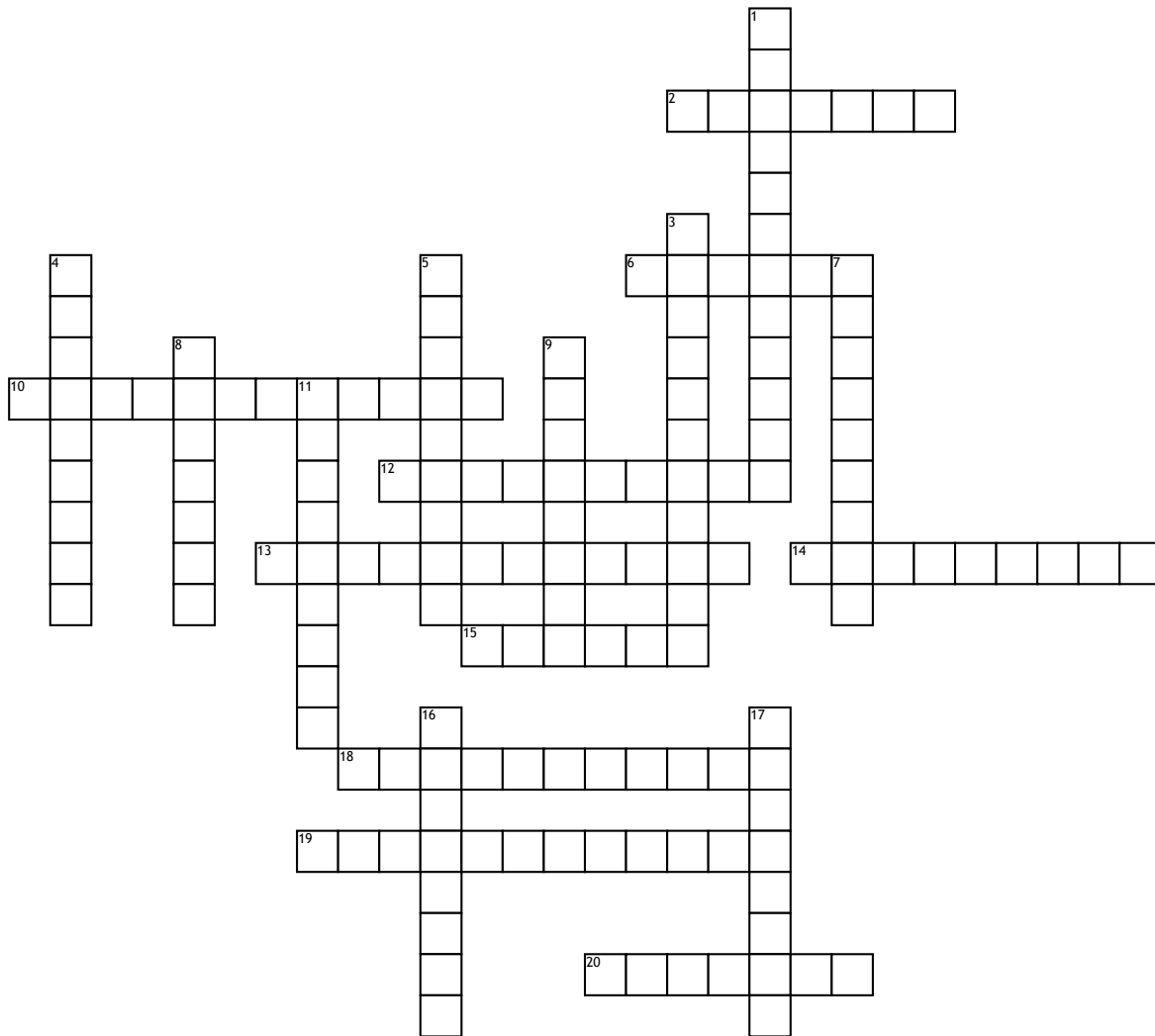


Darkness Before Dawn Crossword
