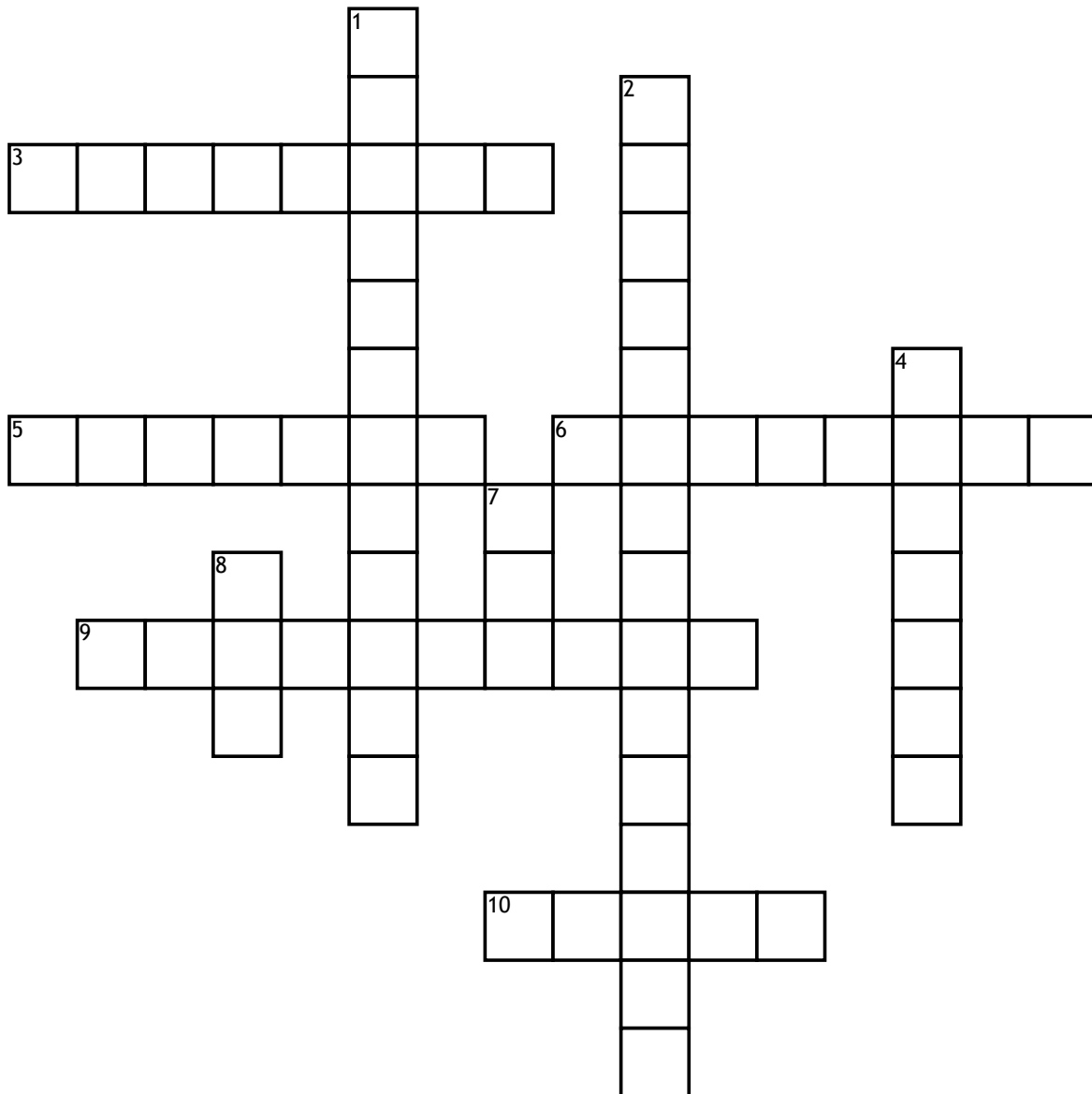

- 9. small device that fits in the ear, worn by partially deaf people to amplify sound
