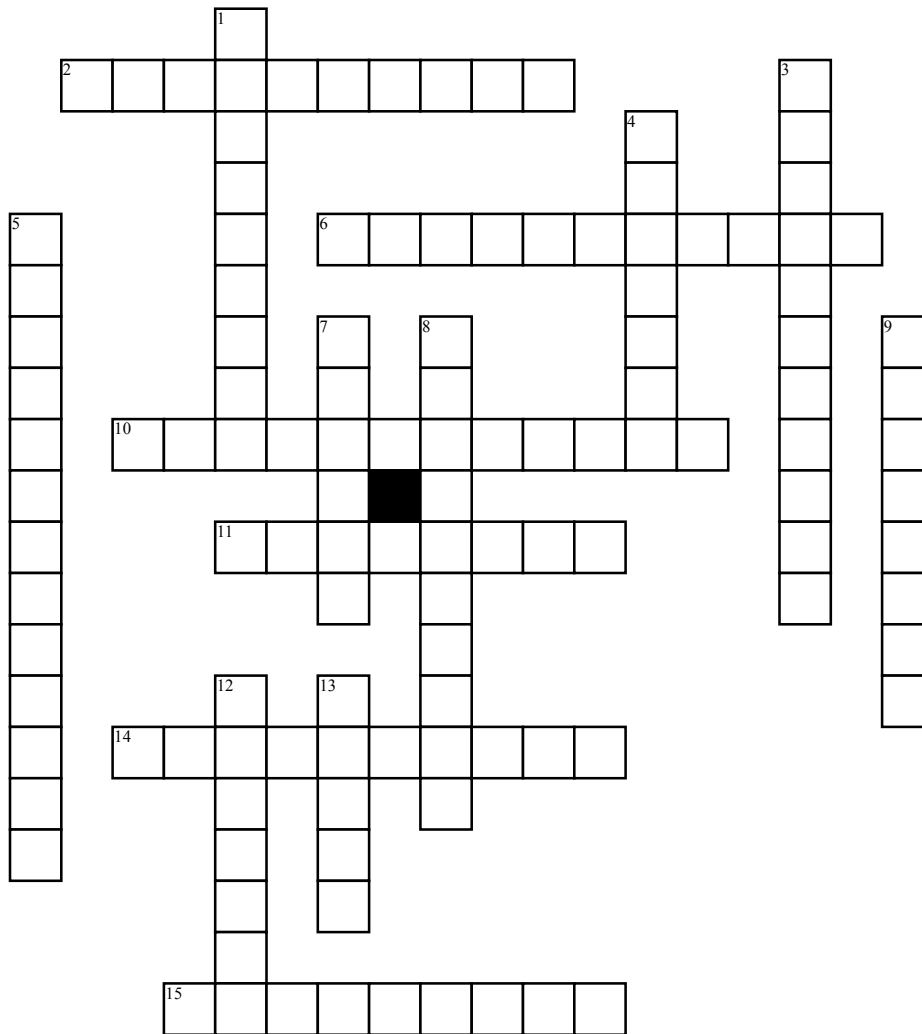


Dear Martin Crossword Puzzle
