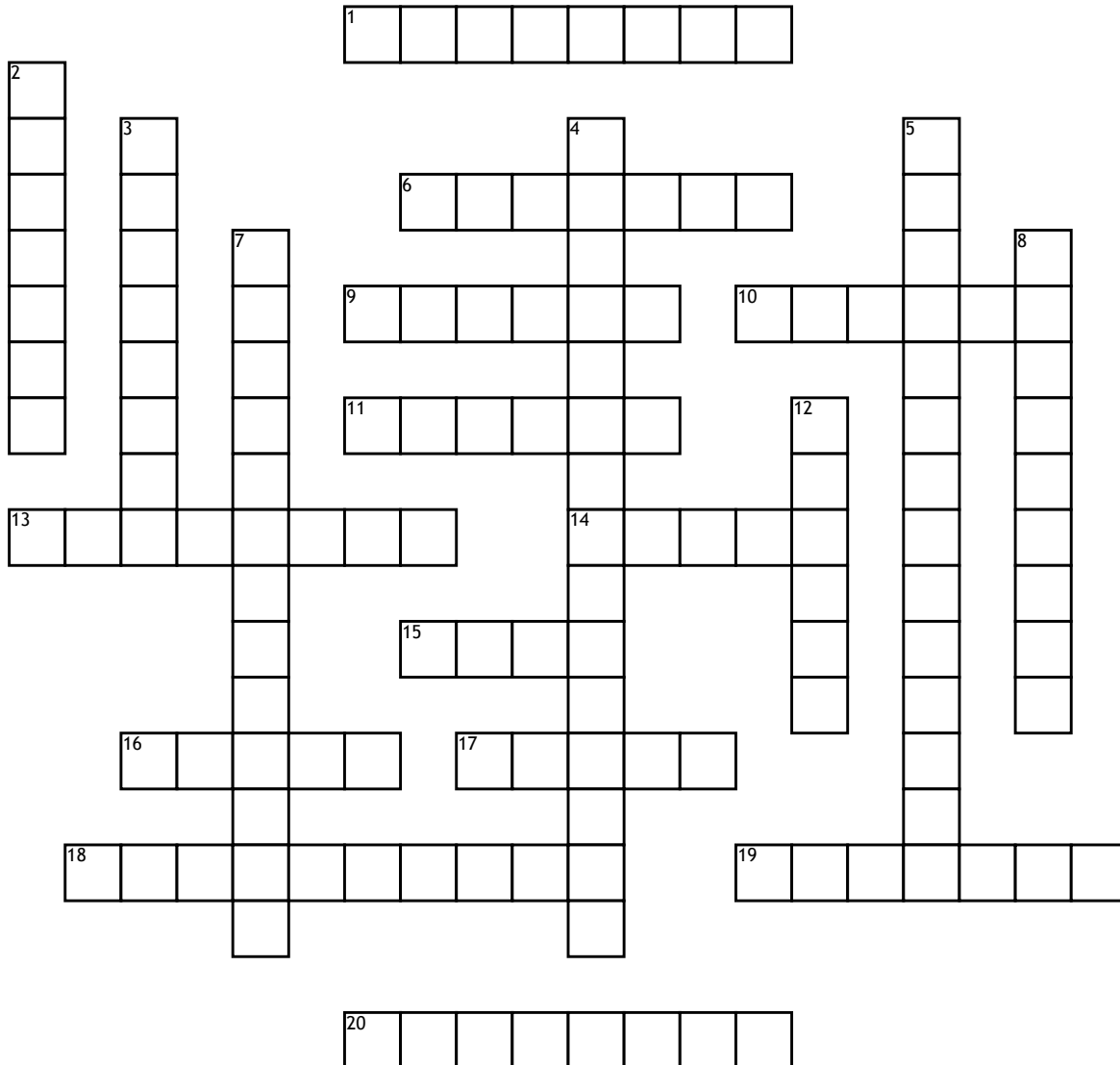


# Death and Culture
