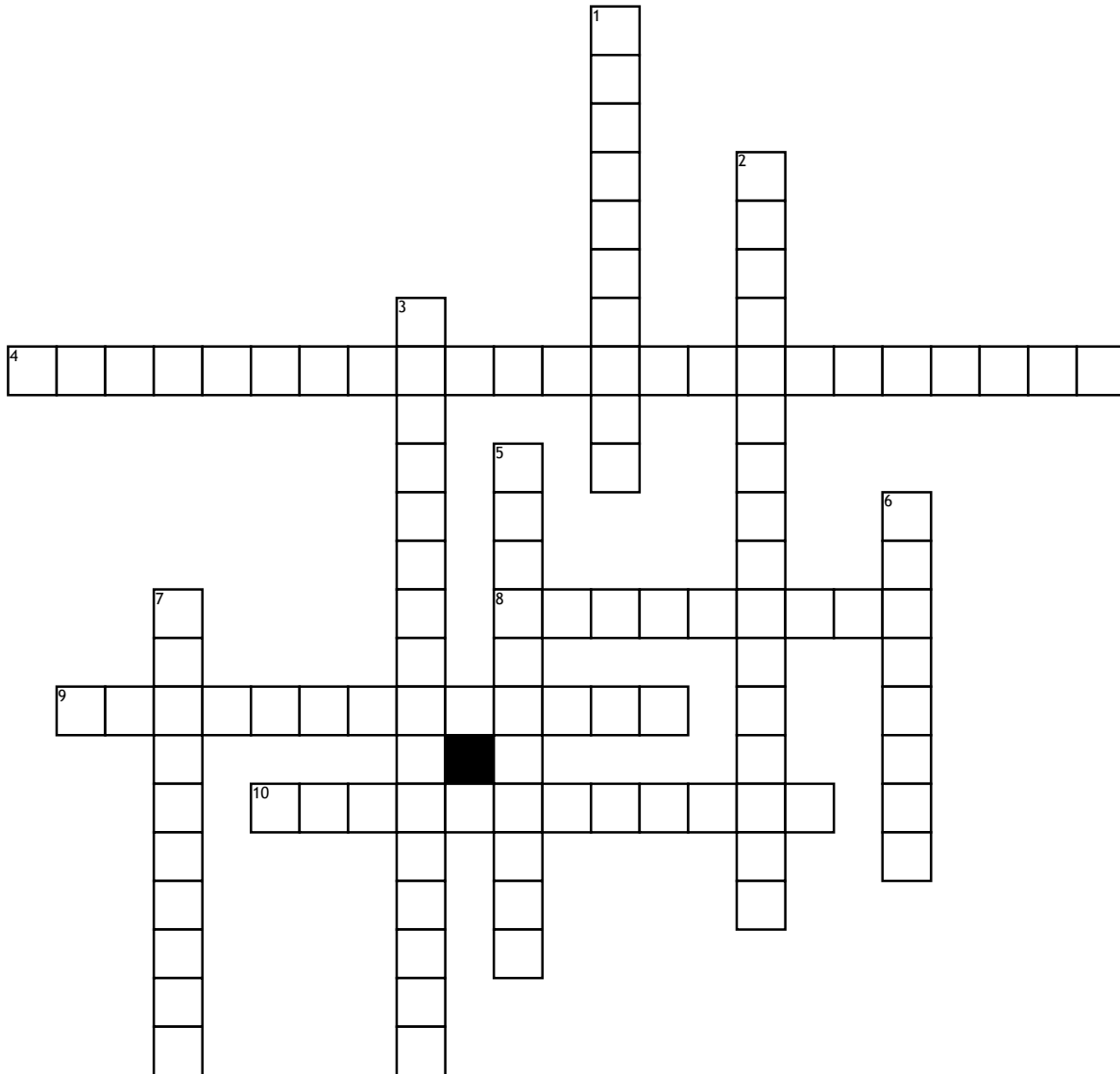

4. Used for replacing the teeth and soft tissues with non-permanent prosthesis that can be removed.
8. An instrument utilized in the removal of damaged tissue from a wound of pulp chambers (cautious) and channels of the teeth.
9. Medical instruments that act as tweezers.
10. Allows indirect vision by the dentist, reflecting light onto desired surfaces, and retraction of soft tissues.

1. A paste or gel dentifrice used with a toothbrush clean and maintain the aesthetics and health of teeth.
2. Used to measure pocket depths around a tooth in order to establish the state of health of the periodontium.
3. Intraoral (inside the mouth), used to reconstruct intraoral defects.
5. Dental instruments used in the prophylactic and periodontal care of teeth.
6. Hand-activated instrument used for scaling and root planing.
7. Used for cutting hard tissues such as bone or tooth.
