

Design of a Keyboard

1. either of two keys on a PC keyboard that is held down while pressing another key, as to issue a command

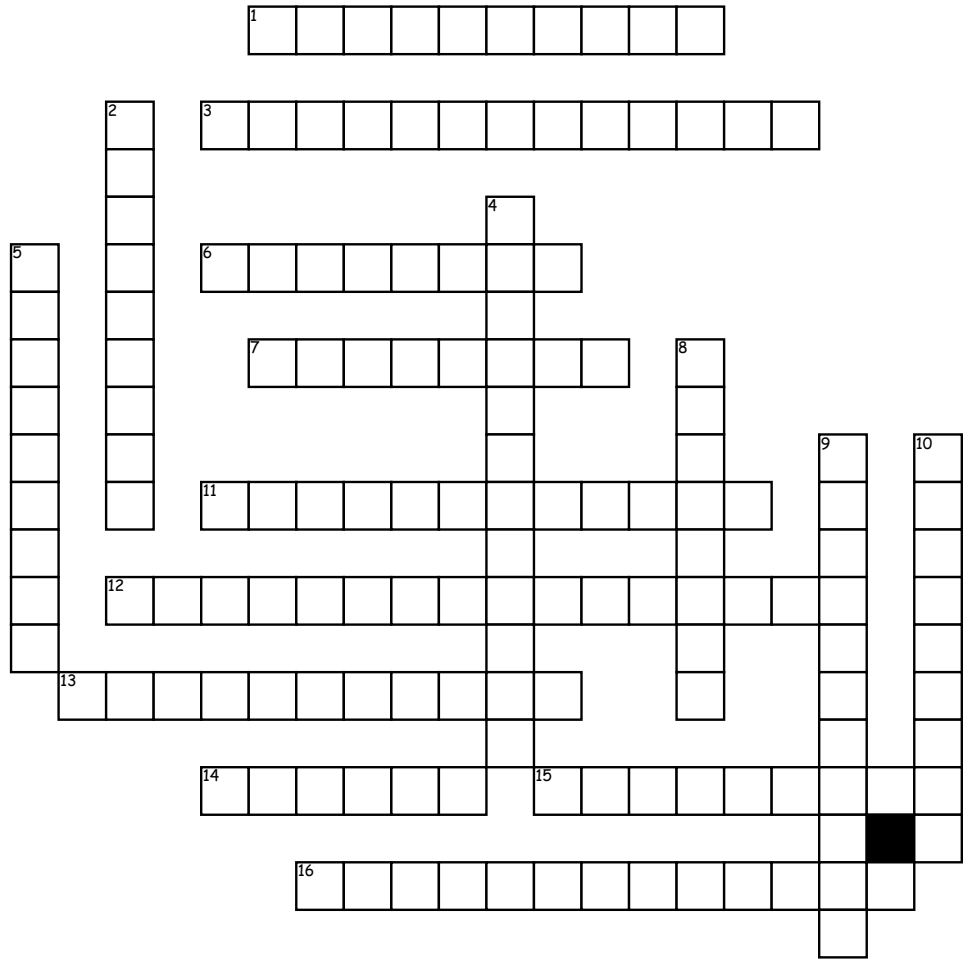
3. Keys at the right side of the keyboard used to enter numeric copy and perform calculations.

6. Inserts a space in the text

7. Makes a capital letters and symbols shown at tops of number keys.

11. It is considered the modifier key or similarly used to the shift and control key

12. Letters, numbers, and symbols



13. Used to execute commands, sometimes with other keys.

14. Moves the insertion point to a present position

15. Removes text to the right of the insertion point.

16. Activates/deactivates numeric keypad

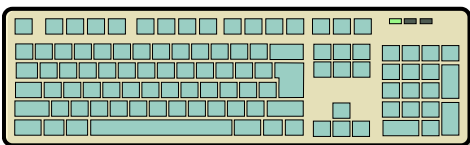
4. Deletes text to the left of the insertion point.

5. Closes a software menu or a dialog box.

8. Moves insertion point to margin and down to next line.

9. Used to make all capital letters.
