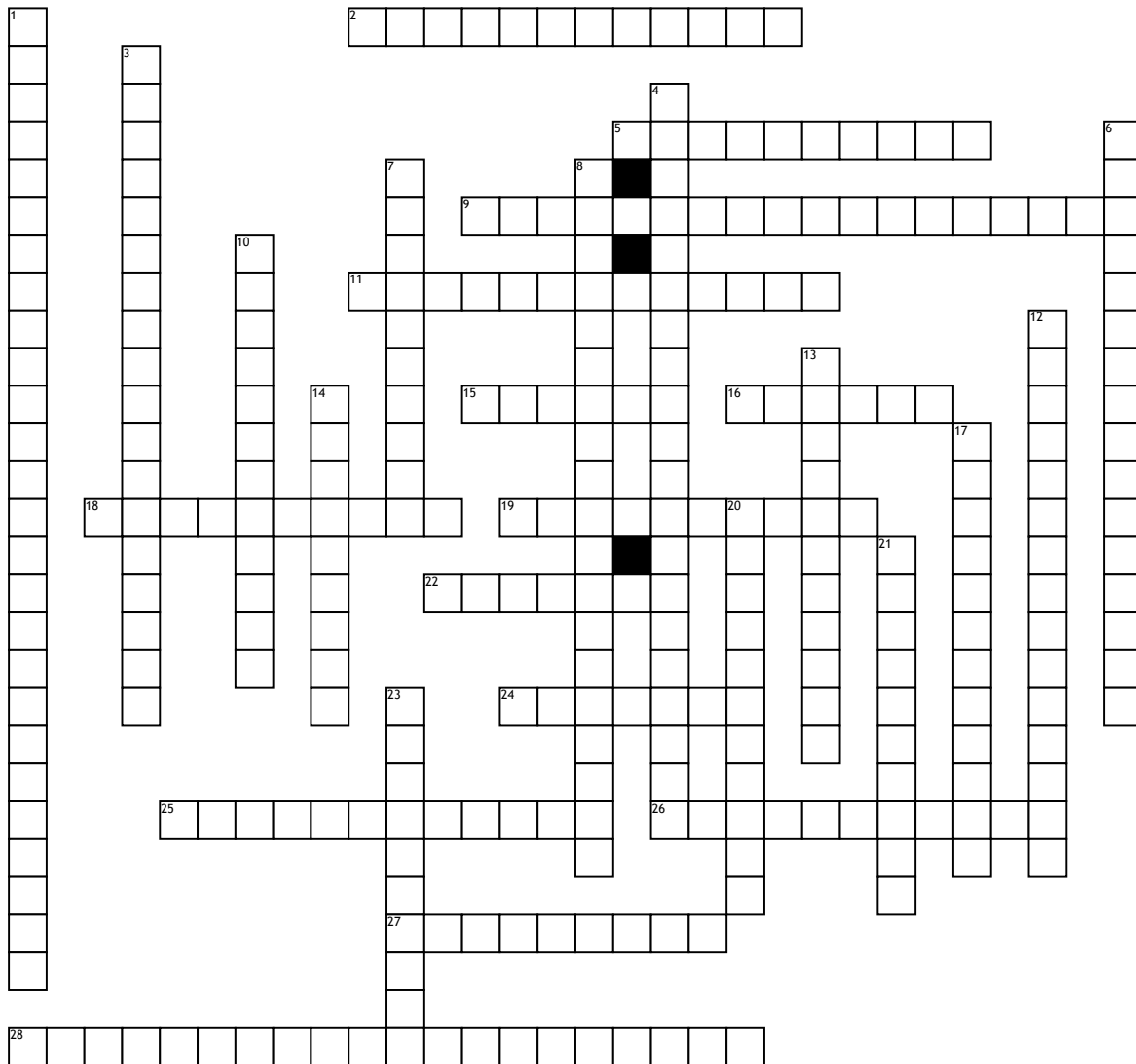

- 18. the skeletal figures that represents death
