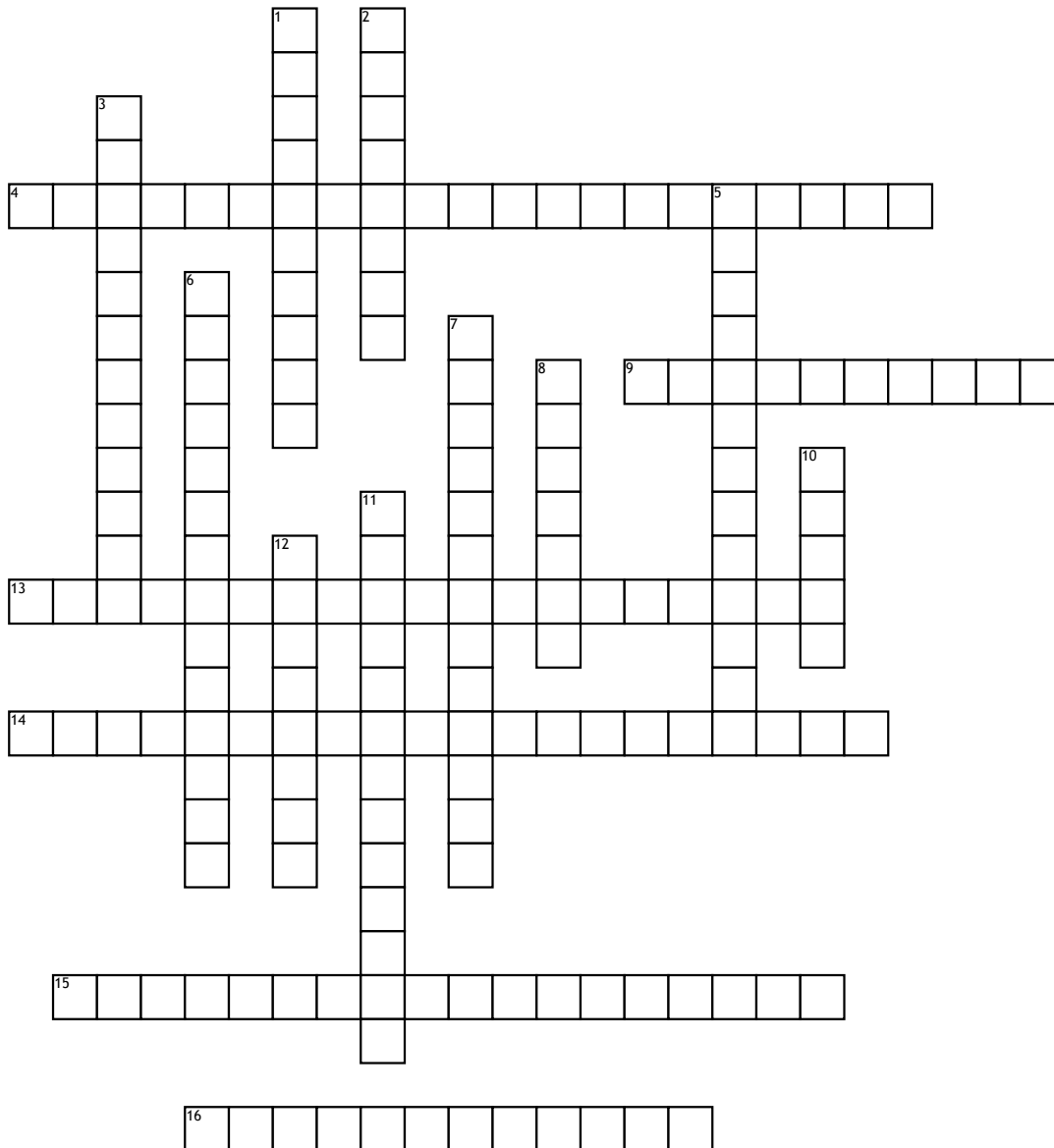


Diabetes and Baby

4. This test measures the number of times a baby kicks in a period of time to watch for activity changes.
9. Imaging test that uses sound waves to monitor baby.
13. Condition that develops during pregnancy and may diminish after delivery. (Affects blood sugar)
14. Screening for gestational diabetes occurs between 24 and 28 weeks using this test.
15. Combination of nonstress test and ultrasound used to check fetal movement, heart rate, and amniotic fluid.
16. Low blood sugar

1. A large baby commonly born to a diabetic mother.
2. This supplies the fetus with nutrients.
3. This condition can develop from high levels of glucose in the body, and can be life-threatening if not treated.
5. Test that measures the fetal heart rate in response to movements.
6. A term that describes women who are diabetic before they become pregnant.
7. High blood sugar

8. When diabetes cannot be controlled with diet or oral medications this may be the next step.
10. Baby's organs develop in this trimester.
11. Test that takes fluid to determine if baby's lungs are mature.
12. A condition in which the body cannot make enough insulin, or cannot use the insulin properly.
