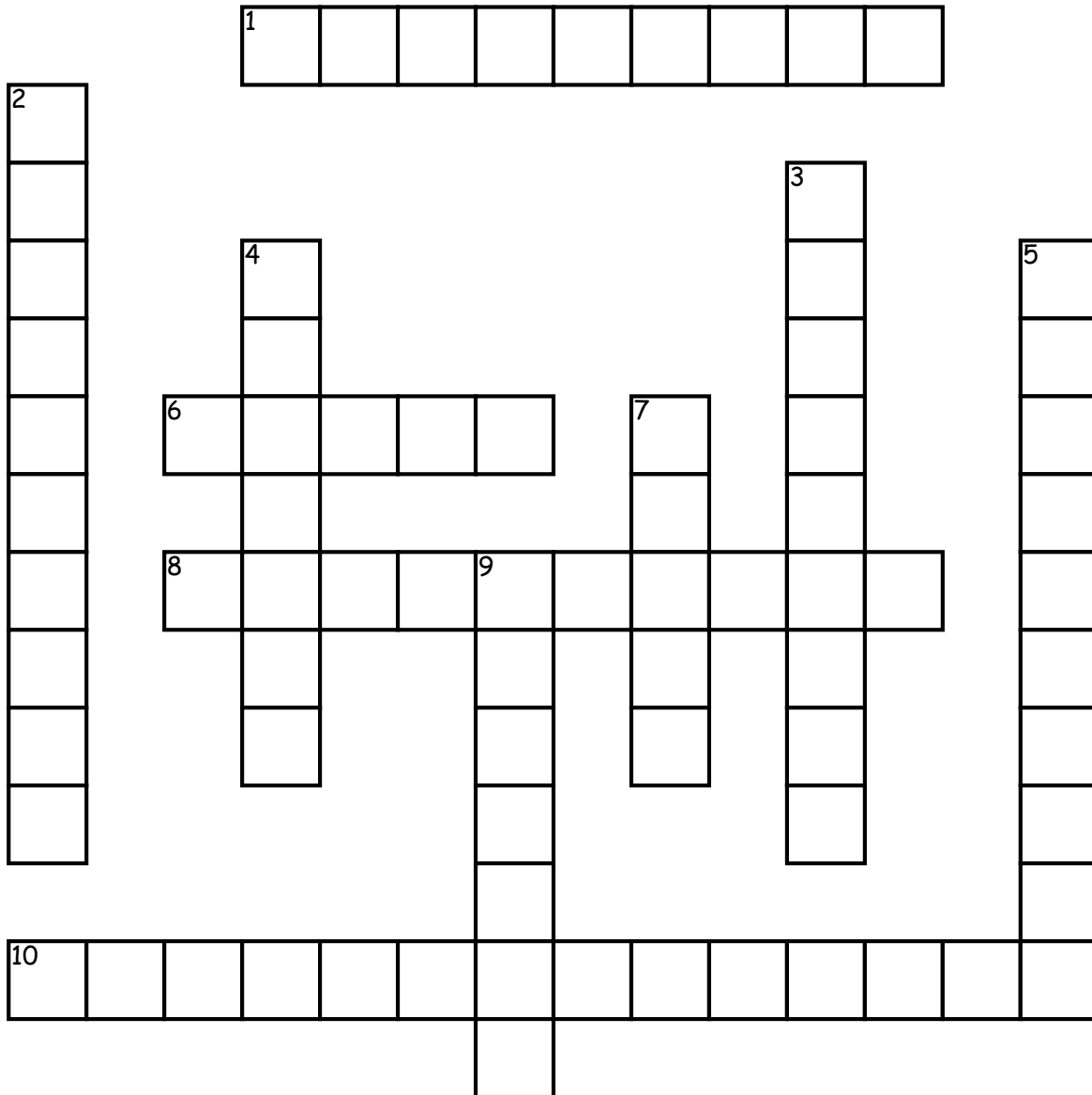


Digestive System



Across

1. literally a food chute; has no digestive or absorptive role
6. organ primarily involved in water absorption and feces formation
8. anterosuperior boundary of the oral cavity; supported by bone
10. organ responsible for most food and water absorption, organ into which the stomach empties, organ that receives pancreatic juice and bile

Down

2. one of the two anatomical regions involved in the physical breakdown of food
3. structure that suspends the small intestine from the posterior body wall, extension of the peritoneum
4. one of the two anatomical regions involved in the physical breakdown of food, organ in which protein digestion begins
5. uvula hangs from its posterior edge
7. fingerlike extensions of the intestinal mucosa that increase the surface area
9. common passage for food and air
