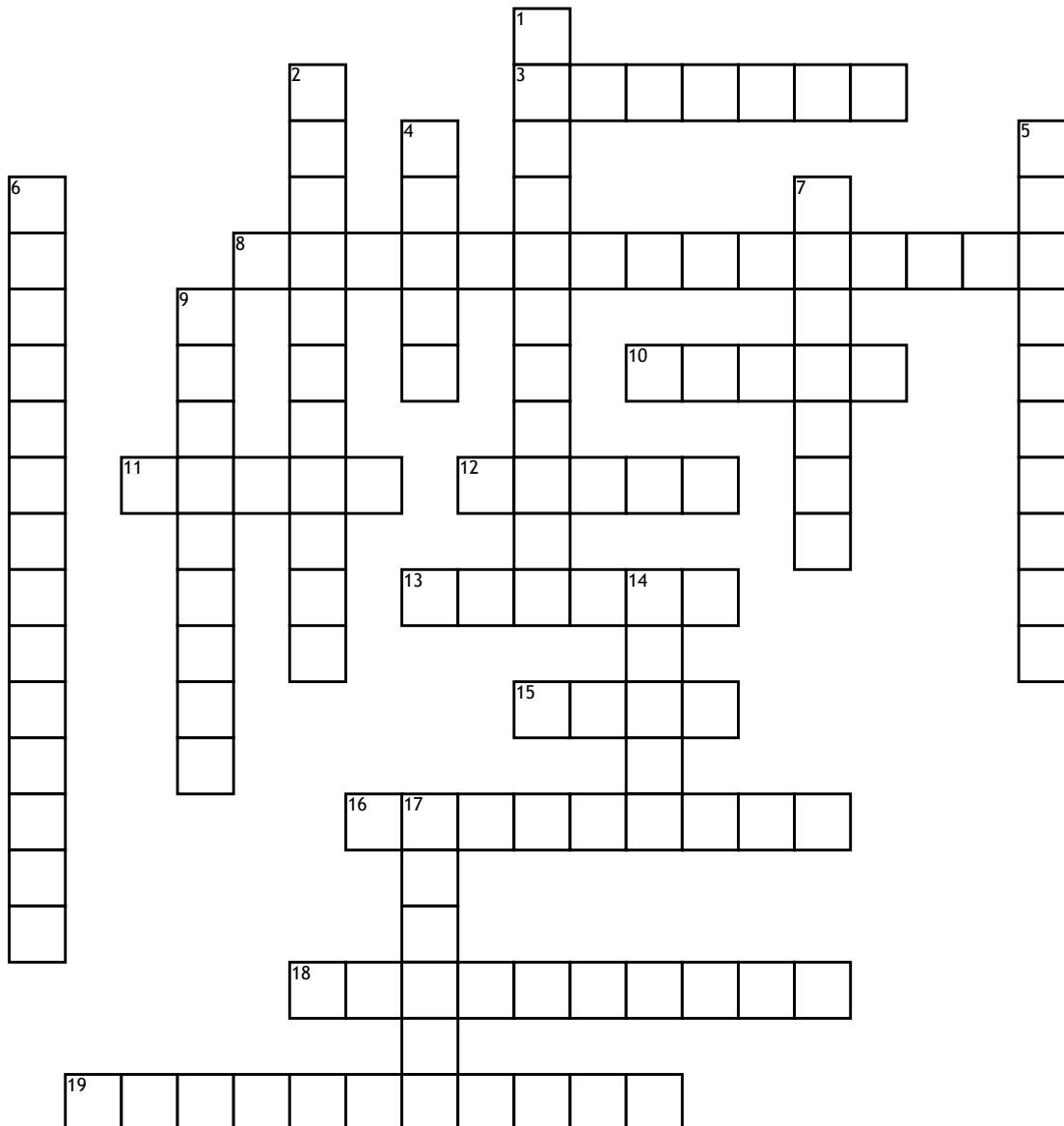


Digestive System

3. Saliva that contains an enzyme that breaks down food in the mouth
 8. Food travels from the stomach to this
 10. A creamy mixture of food and gastric juices
 11. Break food you eat into smaller pieces
 12. Tiny fingerlike projections that help absorb nutrients
 13. Shapes and prepares food for swallowing
 15. human waste exits from here after digestion

16. 10 inch tube that connects the throat to the stomach
 18. Flap of tissue which covers the throat, preventing food from entering your airways.
 19. Series of involuntary muscle contractions that move food through the digestive system

1. The process of chewing
 2. Body's expulsion of undigested food or body wastes
 4. undigested food passes through the large intestine; or the

5. Passage of digested food from digestive tract into blood
 6. in here water is absorbed; helps to eliminate waste.

7. Hollow sac-like organ connected to the esophagus
 9. Breakdown of foods within the stomach and intestines for use of body's cells
 14. Small flap of tissue at the back of the throat that prevents food from going to the nasal passages
 17. Produced by salivary glands
