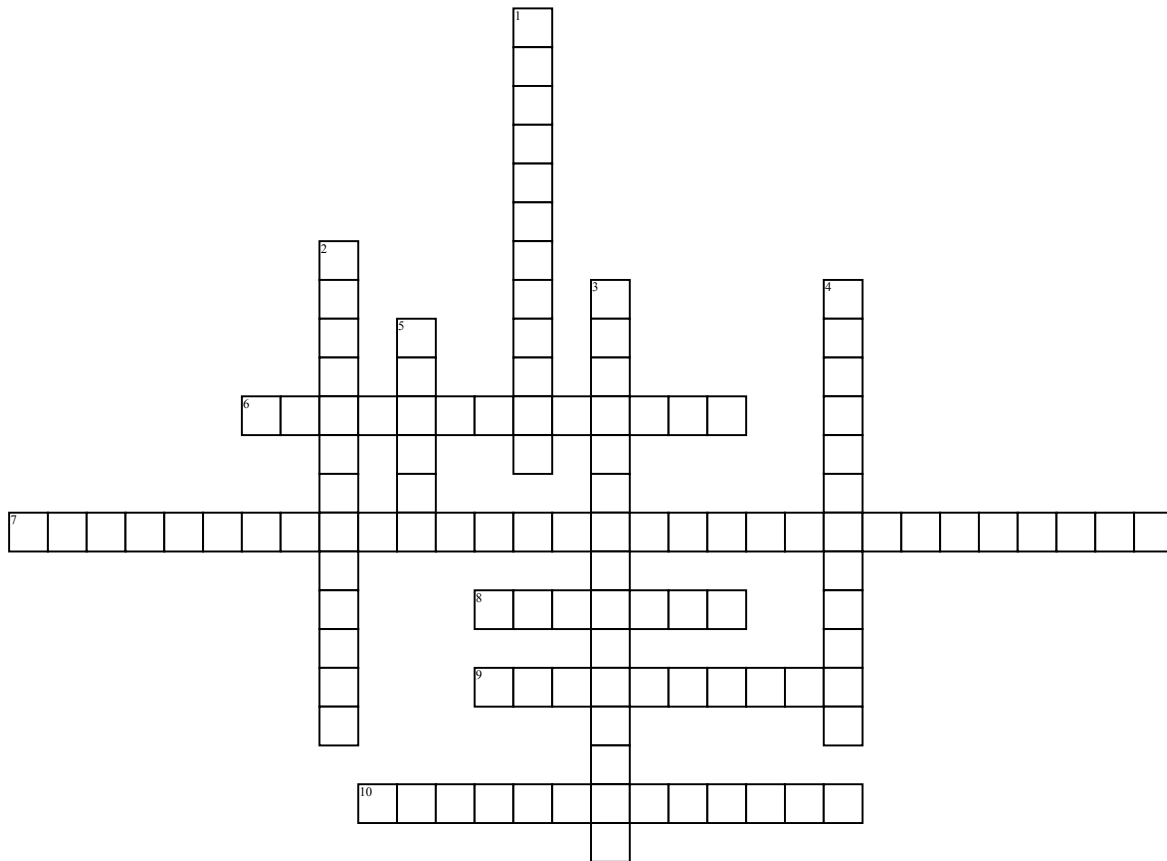


Disability Income and Related Insurance



Across

6. insurance that exceeds in amount the actual value of the person or property insured or insurance in a greater amount than the insured can afford
7. fully insured or currently insured depending on the number of coverage credits earned
8. subject to taxation
9. A portion of the principal sum of a health insurance policy; paid for accidental dismemberment or loss of sight in one eye
10. A period of time during which benefits are paid under the policy

Down

1. The amount of coverage paid for an accidental death under a health insurance policy
2. A qualified expense that may reduce the amount of income subject to taxation
3. Inability of the insured to perform any occupation for which he or she is reasonably suited by reason of education, training or experience
4. Salary, wages, or commissions; but not income from investments, employment benefits, and similar source of income
5. relinquishment of a right or interest
