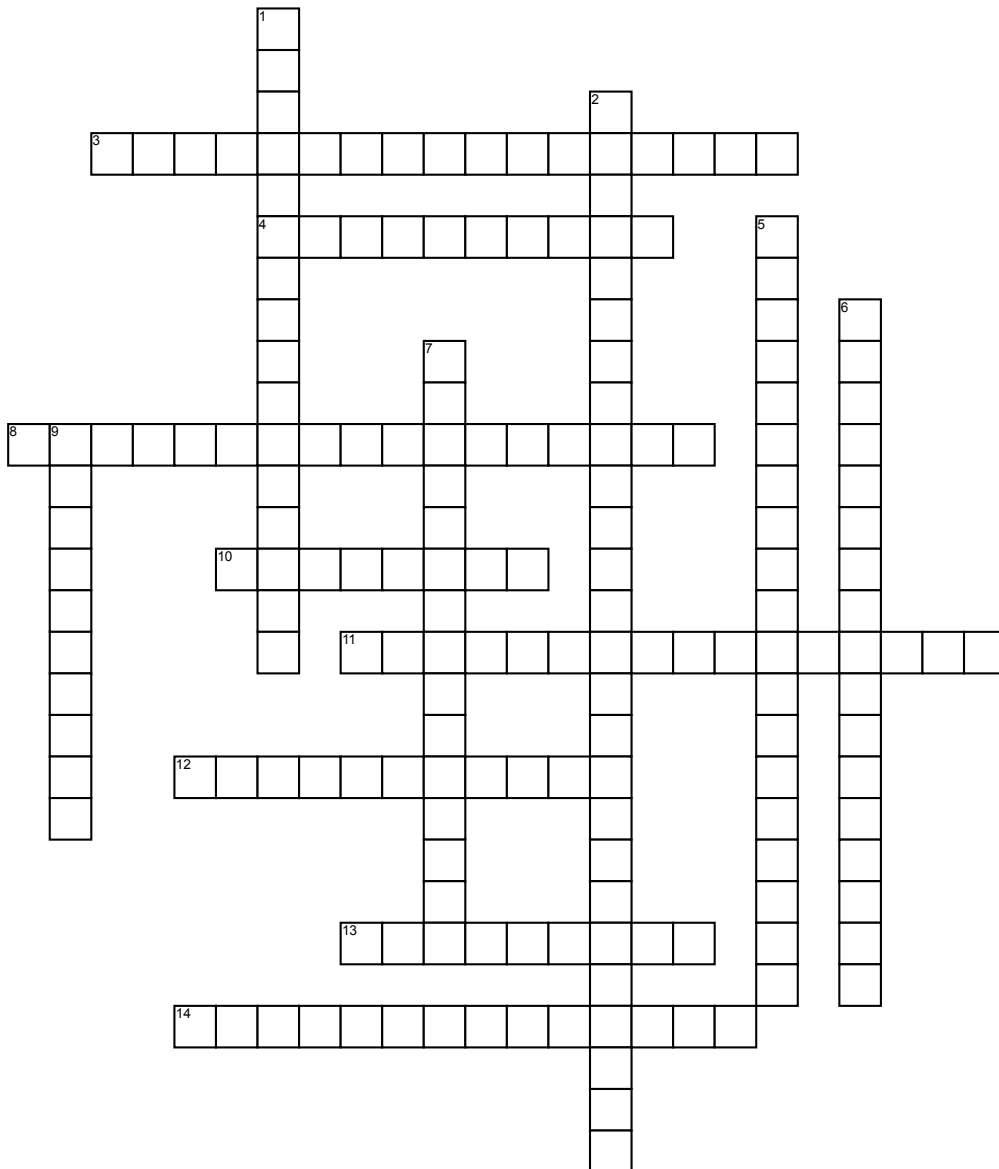


Discharge and Breach of a Contract
