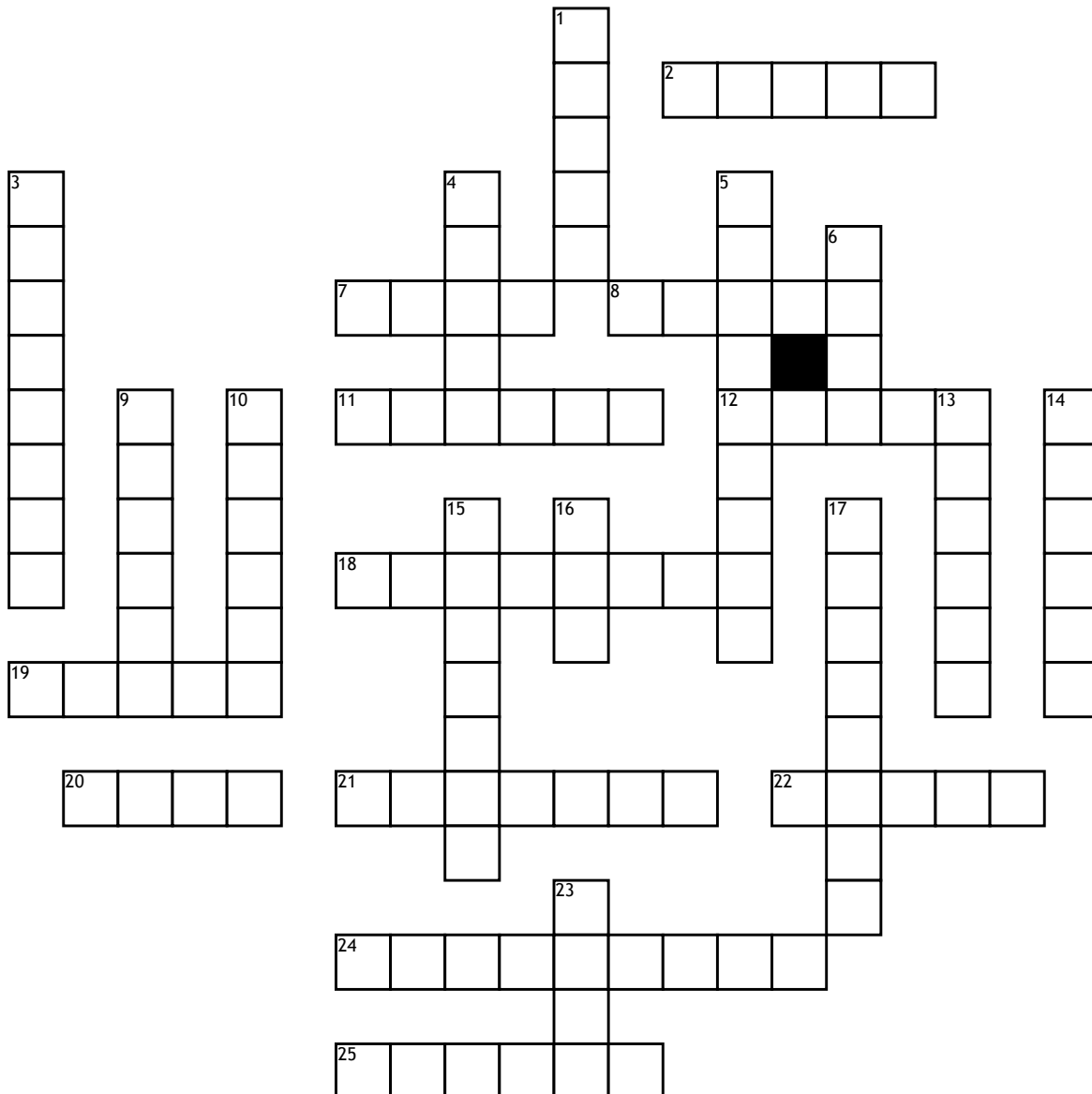


# Door In the Wall
