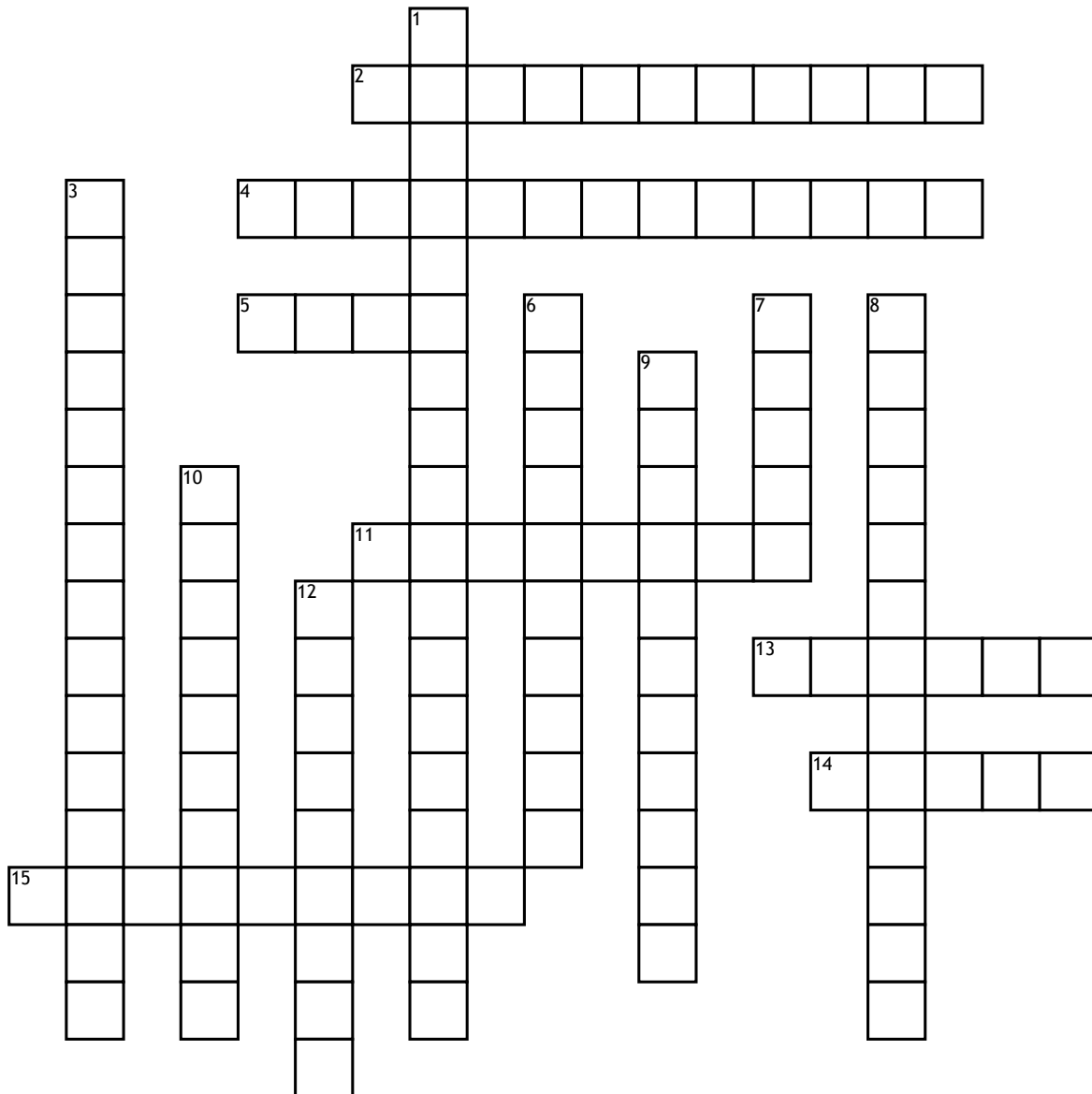


# Drama Conventions
