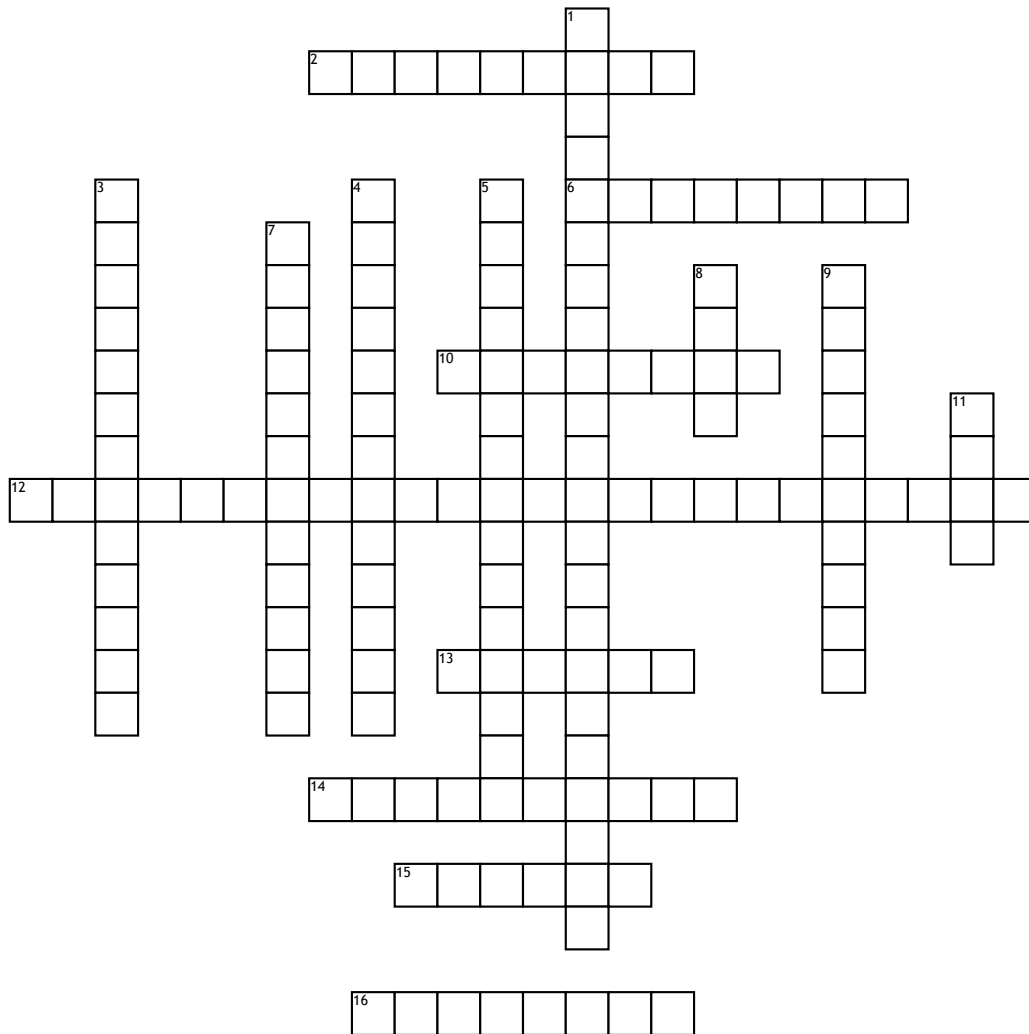


Drama Elements

- 14. portion of the story that introduces important background information to audience

15. creates the movement within a story
