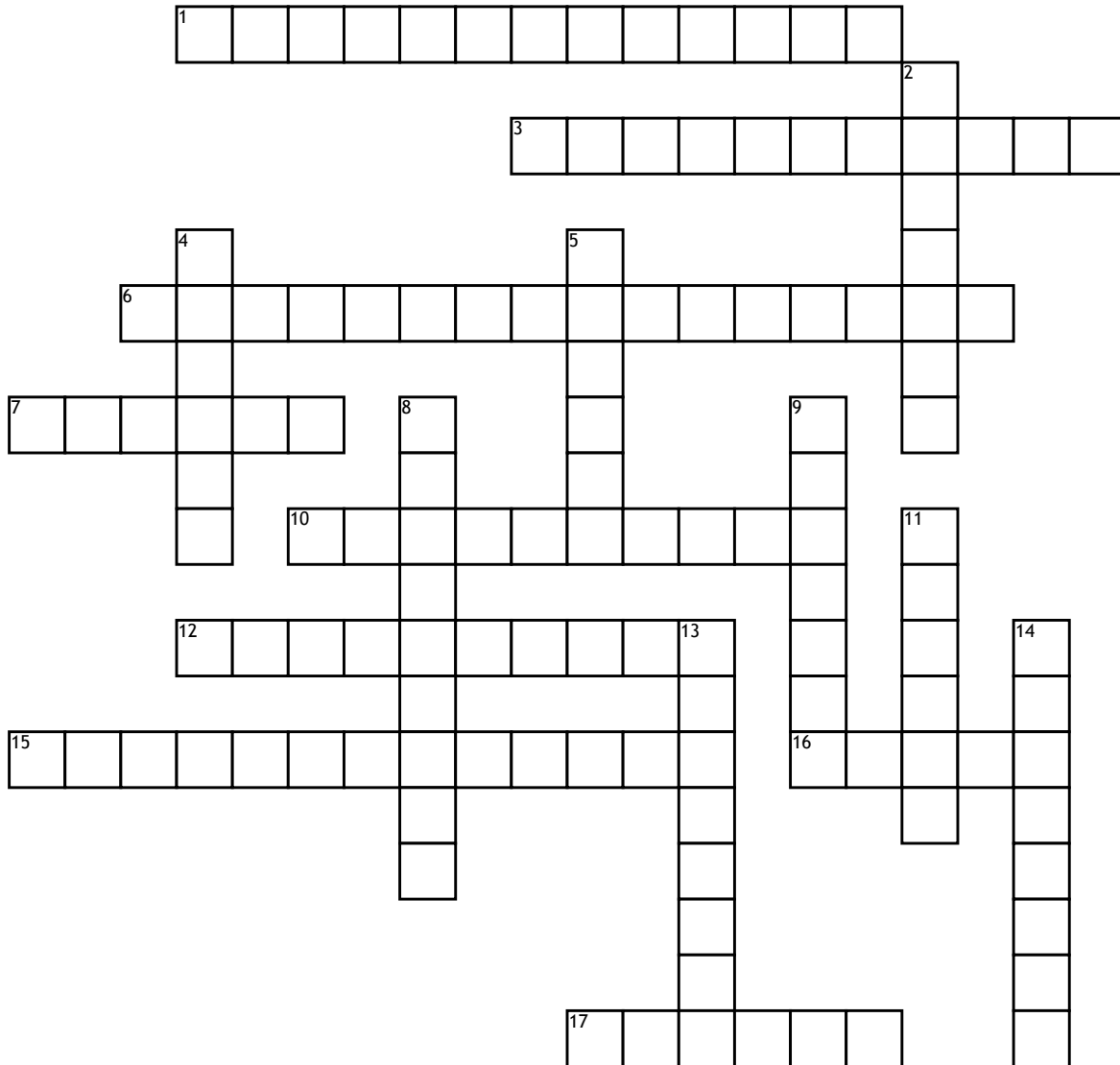

## Across

1. The operator of the lighting or sound board during a performance.
3. A transition where the set or pieces of the set (from the previous scene) are changed over for the next scene.
6. Manages all ticket sales.
7. When props or costume pieces are set onstage before the show begins.
10. Writes the script for the play.
12. The playing area is surrounded by an audience on all four sides.

15. Creates all violence for a production.

16. A thin screen that can be either opaque or translucent.

2. Pipes hung above the stage.
4. One room that does not change from the beginning to the end of the play.
5. A border curtain. A horizontal drapery across the top of the proscenium arch that masks the fly bar.

9. A person who portrays a character in a performance. (female)

11. Works with the house manager to assist patrons in the theatre including guiding them to their seats and distributing programs.

13. The person who analyses the script, creates a vision, guides the production.
