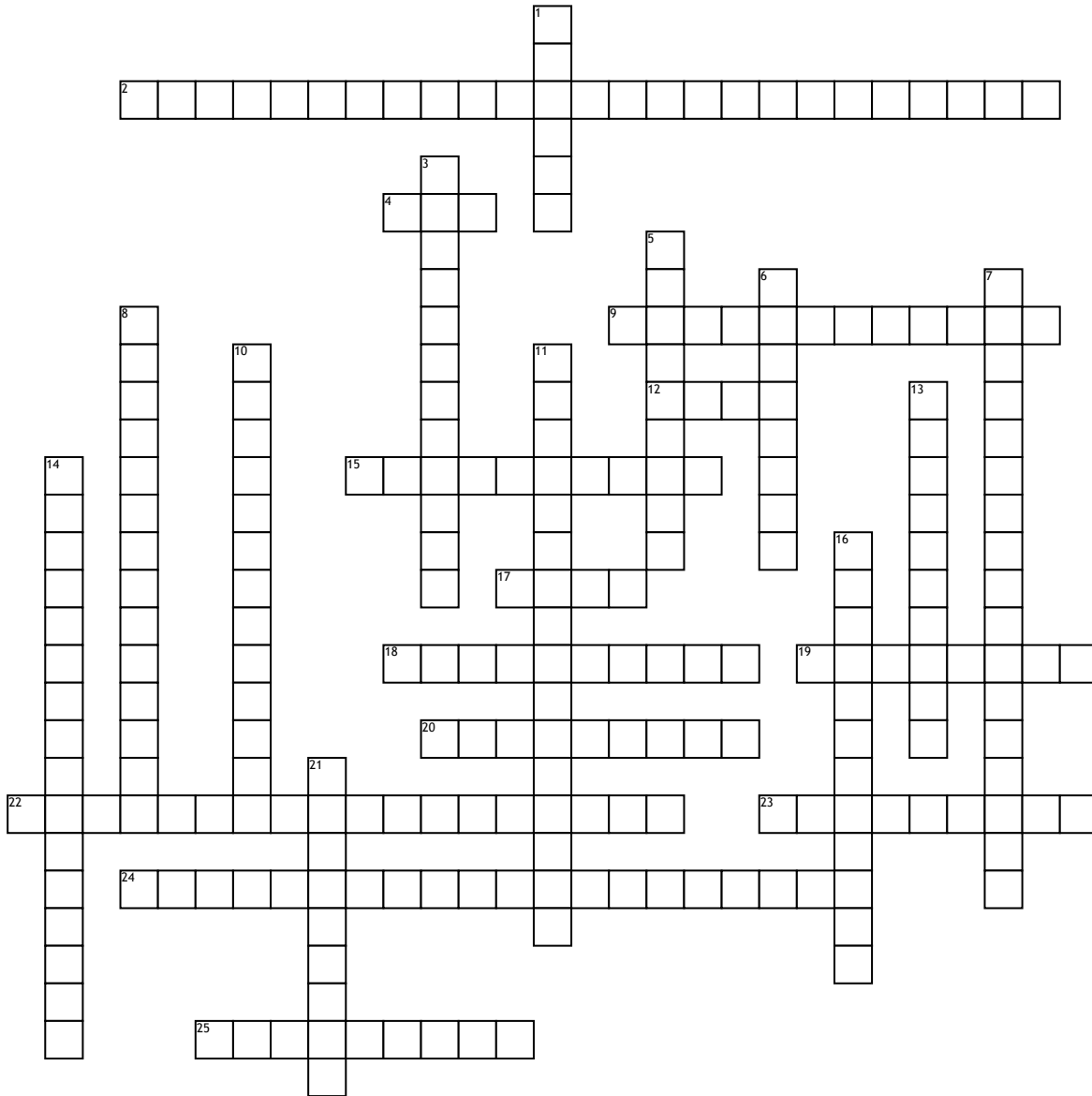

1. Any of several natural or synthetic drugs that relieve pain and cause drowsiness and/or euphoria

7. A state in which a person loses the sense of their reality or perceived their body as unreal
