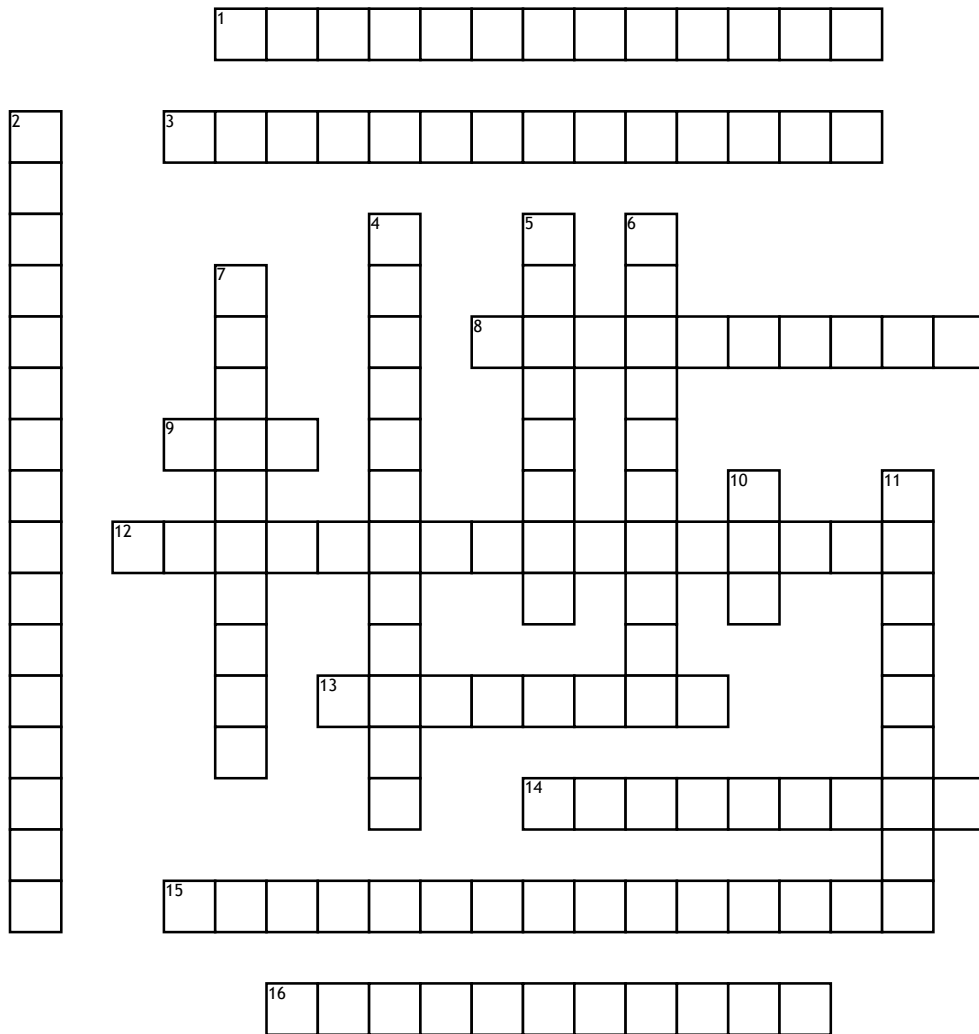


Drug, alcohol and tobacco use
