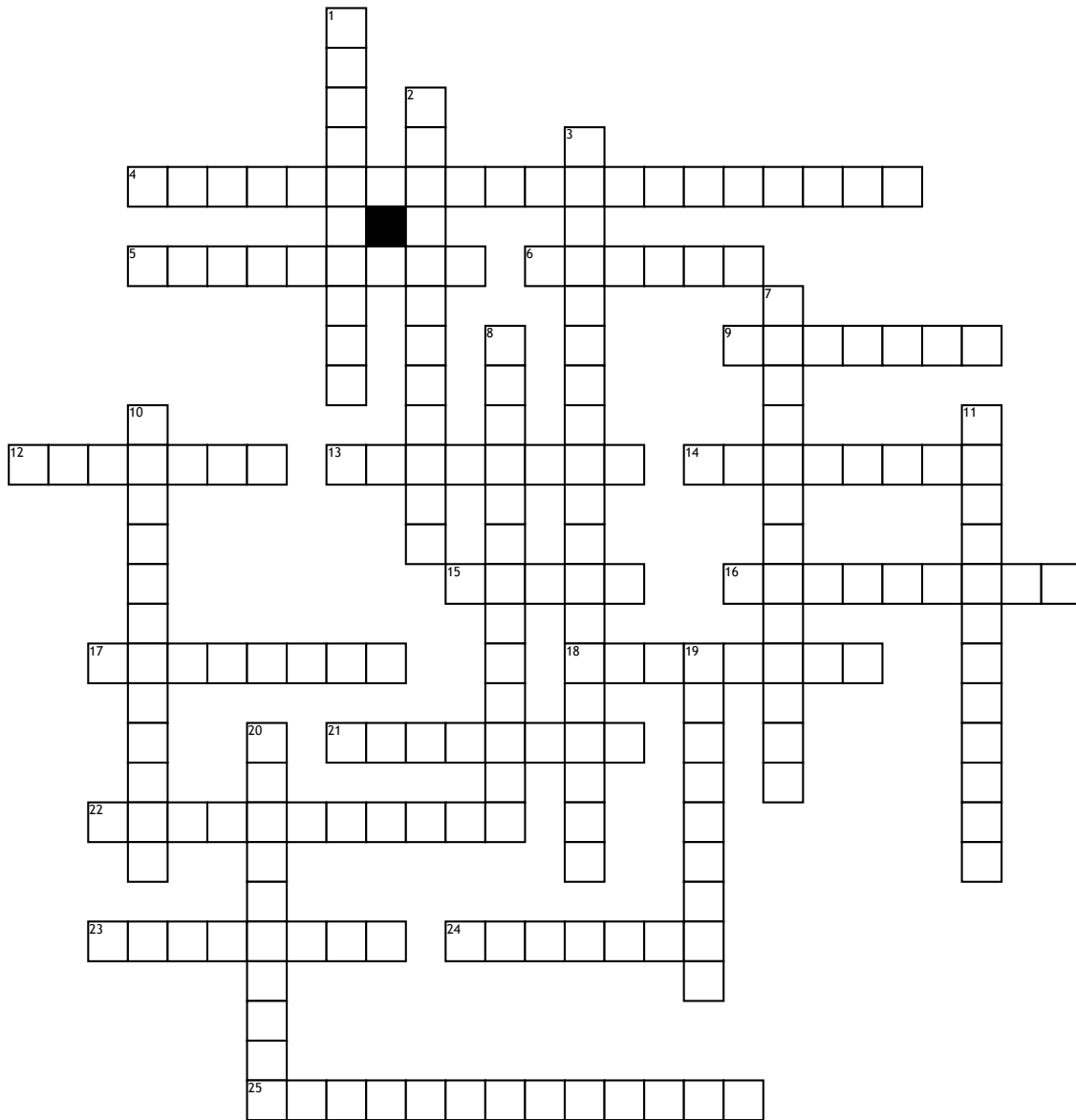

6. a noninfected lesion formed by the buildup of sebum and keratin in a hair follicle
9. the appearance of multiple purple discolorations on the skin caused by bleeding underneath the skin
12. a closed pocket containing pus that is caused by a bacterial infection
13. partial or complete loss of hair
14. a skin condition resulting from the destruction of the melanocytes due to unknown causes

15. small, itchy bumps usually caused by an allergic reaction
16. small pinpoint hemorrhages under the skin
17. a genetic condition characterized by a deficiency or the absence of pigment in the skin, hair, and irises of the eyes
18. discolorations caused by sun exposure
21. injury in which superficial layers of skin are scraped
22. profuse sweating
23. an intensely itchy rash caused by blockage of the sweat glands by bacteria and dead cells
24. a groove or crack-like break in the skin
25. a closed sac associated with a sebaceous gland that is found just under the skin

1. a torn or jagged wound or an accidental cut wound
2. an open ulcerated wound caused by prolonged pressure on an area of skin
3. a benign skin growth that has a waxy or "pasted-on" look. Can vary in color from light tan to black. Most common in the elderly.
7. a deep hole made by a sharp object
8. a condition of excessive sweating in one area or over the whole body
10. a chronic inflammatory disease characterized by pustular eruptions of the skin caused by an overproduction of sebum
11. inflammation of the hair follicles
19. overactivity of the sebaceous glands that result in the overproduction of sebum
20. abnormal condition of no sweat
