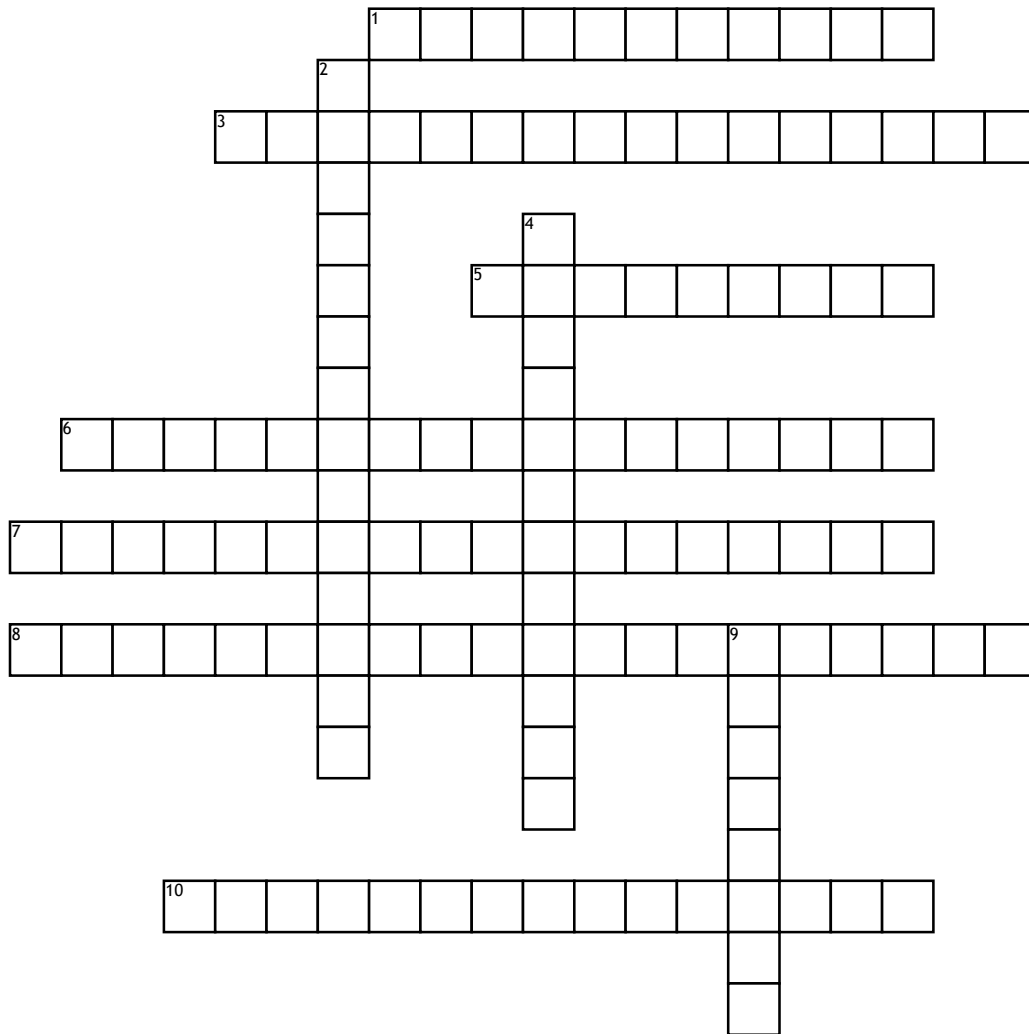


Durkheim's Modernity
